3rd Seth Jagannath Bajaj Memorial RNBGU National Moot Court Competition:

The School of Law conducted the 3rd National Moot Court competition from 1st to 3rd February, 2020 where the students participated from all over India from different prestigious law schools. Moot Court was one attempt of creating a simulated atmosphere for the future lawyers and judicial officers. The objective was to allow the Law Students to delve into intricacies of the given field of law and to provide a real-life experience cum training in doing cutting edge research, presenting ground breaking arguments and contributing to the development of theories of law. This prestigious session had

the presence of '*Honourable Justice J. K. Ranka and Honourable Justice Manak Mohta*' (Retired High Court Justice, Rajasthan High Court). In addition to this, the dignitaries comprised of other eminent personalities in the field of law such as '*Mr. Jitendra Singh Yadav, Dr. Kumud Jain and Mr. Mumtaaj Ali Bhati* (President, Bar Association of Bikaner)'



Visit to Supreme Court: One of the most prestigious and notable activity conducted by the School of Law was a visit to Supreme Court during 17th to 19th October, 2019, the highest constitutional court of India. The students had the privilege of witnessing the functioning of the highest level of judiciary in India. The renowned practicing lawyers of the highest court gave the needed briefings to the students which is a pre-requisite of the legal profession. The visit gave our students ample amount of time to understand the profession of law at ground level and the hearing of the cases as well. This prestigious visit has made the students of the School of Law more confident and industry ready. The students are now well equipped to understand the basics of hearing, trials and dates.

RNBian's Visited Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur: Students of School of Law, RNB Global University visited the Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur from 7th to 9th March, 2019. The visit was permitted by the Registrar of the High Court Bench. The day started with a brief note given to the students about the court and court rooms by a practicing lawyer at High Court of Rajasthan. He guided all the students and dictated the Jurisdiction of the High Court Bench. He explained about Division Bench which consists of 2 Judges and Single Bench which consists of 1 Judge. The students were divided in six groups and each group was allowed to visit separate court room. They visited court number 11 to 16. In court room no. 11, there was an argument between the lawyer and the Honourable Justices. The case was related to the merit list of Rajasthan Administration services examination.



Visit to Chandigarh High Court: On 18th October, 2019, the students visited Punjab and Haryana High Court, they visited Court of Chief Justice of High Court and they listened the proceedings of the Court related to the cases of farmers. Students also visited the High Court Library and found a large number of books and reports, students also obtained supplementary directory from the library and spent around two hours in the court. This enriching experience helped the students in gaining practical

exposure of various proceedings happening within the court. Moreover, this prestigious visit also gave the students the exposure of crucial reading material present within the courts and libraries.

Moot Court Training for Law Students: On 23rd January, 2020, a session was conducted by 'Mr. Anant having worked at Sharda Amarchand Mangaldas and Mr. Rachnendra' practising litigation, for enhancing the mootng capability of the students'. Soon after the inaugural session, the first working session on "Decoding the moot proposition" began. First, they discussed about extracting the material facts where the students were told to read the moot problem, mark new words along with name of statutes and new concepts. Then they were told to analyse the applicable statutes in moot proposition which helped students to identify the law applicable in moot proposition.



Constitution Day Celebration at RNB Global University: Constitution Day, also known as Samvidhan Divas, is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of Constitution of India. On this day in 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950. On 29th November, 2019 all the faculty members and students gathered in the Seminar Hall, Administrative Block in order to celebrate the connection between the Constitution and citizenship. The function aimed to reflect on what it means to be a citizen of India; what are Fundamental Rights provided to every citizen residing on this glorious land and what fundamental duties

are expected from them. The Constitution plays a meaningful role in the life of every Indian. It not only establishes the rule of law, but also ensures that every citizen lives with the same rights, privileges and responsibilities as any other.

Visit to District and Session Court Bikaner for Lok Adalat: Students from School of Law, RNB Global University attended Lok Adalat, District and Session Court Bikaner on 14th September, 2019. The Purpose of the visit was to understand the working of courts and the nature of duties of judicial officers in the matter of Lok Adalat. The visit was to help the students understand the role of Lok Adalats in dispensing justice. The role of prosecutors in a case, the way cases proceed in the court, the way judges and defence lawyers handle the cases. The relationship between prosecutors and the police. The visit gave students, an opportunity to understand the actual need of coordination in the four pillars of Procedural Justice. "Lok Adalat (People's Court) is one of alternative dispute resolution mechanisms in India.



Mock United Nations Sessions: The school of Law conducted the Mock United Nations Session on 6th September, 2019. This programme not only witnessed participation of the students of RNB Global University but students from other institutions were also invited who participated enthusiastically. Thus, it really became a learning session. In this Session fourteen countries participated. In the two days programme, there were four sessions- First Session was General Assembly Session, speeches of heads of government of UN member countries were delivered with full conviction, second session was based on Economic and Social Council Session, in this session report on WHO, Violation of Human Right of Political Prisoners etc. were presented by students, Third Session was Security Council, the topics that were focus

of the debate were Threat to Peace by Nuclear Programme of North Korea, etc.

Trial Advocacy Competition Organised with Huge success: Trial advocacy is the branch of knowledge concerned with making attorneys and other advocates more effective in trial proceedings. Trial advocacy is taught in primary, secondary, and undergraduate schools (usually associated with a mock trial elective). It is taught as an essential trade skill for litigators in Law Schools and in continuing legal education programs. Trial advocacy is the art of persuasion before a court or tribunal. School of Law, RNBGU seeks to provide a platform for exchange of ideas and experience between students across all students of School of Law. This competition was conducted on 13th August, 2019 and the case (Magan v/s Roop Kanwar) was discussed in this competition and was based on a decided case of Supreme Court of India named Naveen Kohli vs Neelu Kohli Appeal (Civil) 812 of 2004. Topic of this competition was-'A petition for divorce filed by husband under section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955.



Two days National Conference on Emerging Horizons of Indian law: On Fourteenth December, 2019, Honourable Chief Guest 'Prof. U. C. Sankhala', Former Vice Chancellor, B.R. Ambedkar Rajasthan Law University, inaugurated the two-day national conference in presence of 'Prof. (Dr.) Komal Audichya', JNU University and 'Dr. Anjay Kumar'. The program comprised of an inaugural session and three working sessions on each day of the conference. The conference comprised of presentation of quality papers on both the days and turned out to be a very enriching session.

Students Shine in Mock Parliament: A Mock Parliament session was held at RNBGU on 17th February, 2020 where the enthusiasm with which the students participated left everyone amazed. The students mock Parliament had both the ruling and the opposition parties at the right and left sides respectively Ms. Sejal Kanwar and Mr. Yashpal Kumar played the role of Prime Minister while Mr. Piyush Tripathi and Mr. Arif Khan were the leaders of opposition. Mr. Shubham Singh and Mr. Piyush Tripathi acted as Speakers of the House. It was unlike the ones seen in the Parliament these days which is dominated by confusion and quarrel. *Justice Madanlal Bhati, District and Session Judge, Bikaner* was the chief guest and *Shri Ravikant Verma, Kishore Singh Shekhawat, Ex-Presidents Bikaner Bar Association, Prof. Usha Karkara, former Dean, Law Dept.
