His insights into the electoral process and the importance of informed voting were well received by attendees.

On April 11, 2024, The campaign continued with a Voting Awareness Campaign at Husangsar, Bikaner. Volunteers interacted with residents, providing information on how to register to vote and the im-

portance of each vote in shaping the future of the community. While on April 12, 2024 a Debate Competition was held at RNB University campus on the



topic, "Should Lok Sabha and State Assembly Elections be held together or separately?"

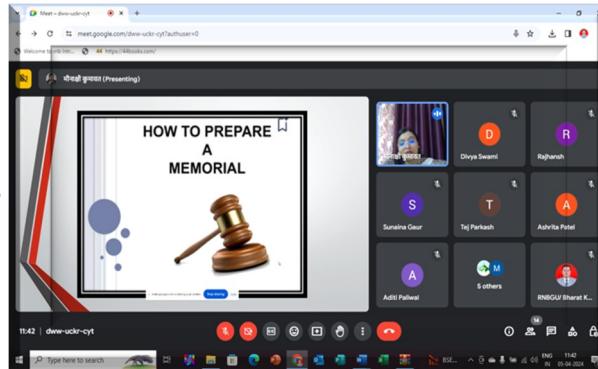
