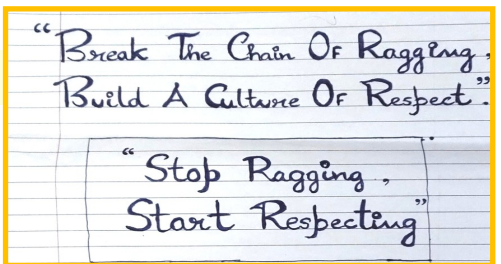

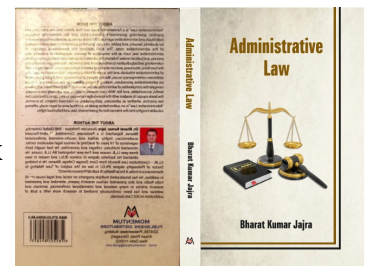
## RNB GU Celebrates 78th Independence Day with Flag Hoisting Ceremony
