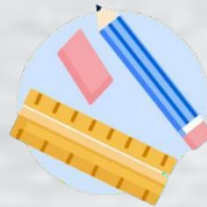

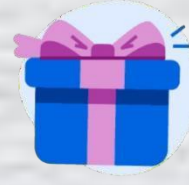

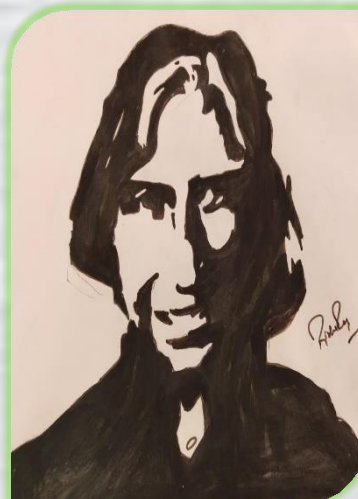

“I participated as a speaker in the moot court competition conducted by IILM competition. It was a three day competition and I was the speaker of my team. The most important thing that I learnt is that Moot court is all about team work and practice, it is based on how much coordination you have with your teammates. The other important thing I learned is research from making your arguments to the memorandum everything is based on research. I learnt what sites should be referred to find the perfect material, what is needed for making the perfect Memorial, and this research is the backbone of the competition. I also learnt the etiquettes that are being followed in a courtroom and how important it is to follow them and as a speaker the most important things you need to possess is confidence and knowledge about what you will be serving the judges. Overall, it was a great experience I receive the lot of help from my seniors and teachers and they thought me everything important about Moot court. I was appreciated by the judges for my arguments and the memorial my team was in the top six teams that got selected for the quarter finals this was my first experience a lot to learn.”
