On December 5, 2024, the School of Agriculture at RNB Global University celebrated World Soil Day. The event featured President

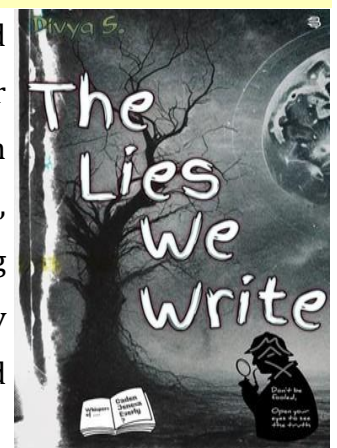

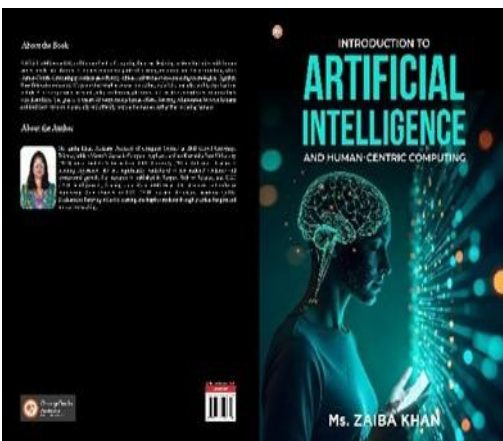
## Festive Celebrations: Christmas and New Year 2024
