

8th Seth Jagannath Bajaj Memorial RNBGU National Moot Court Competition—2025



The 8th Seth Jagannath Bajaj Memorial RNBGU National Moot Court Competition, hosted by the Faculty of Law and Arts, RNB Global University, Bikaner, Held from February 7 to 9, the competition saw the participation of 34 teams out of 35 registered teams from reputed law schools across the country.

Kanoria School of Law for Women, Jaipur, emerged as the champion, securing a cash prize of ₹51,000. Kalinga University, Raipur, finished as the runner-up in the closely contested finals and secure ₹21,000.

The competition also recognized individual excellence. Mitali Thakur from Kalinga University, Raipur, was awarded Best Speaker (Female), while Sagar Singh from the Institute

of Law, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, won Best Speaker (Male). The Best Researcher award went to Jashanpreet from the University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh.
