Guest Lecture on Open-Source Software and DevOps Practices Held

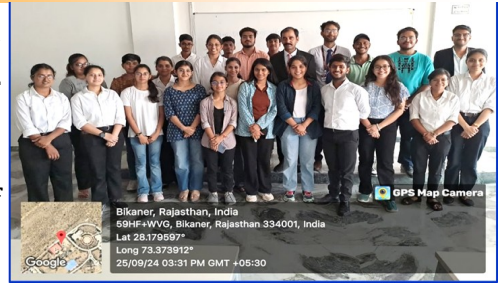
On September 30, 2024, a guest lecture on "Open-Source
