B.Sc. Agriculture Students Explore Sustainable Farming Innovations at SKRAU, Bikaner

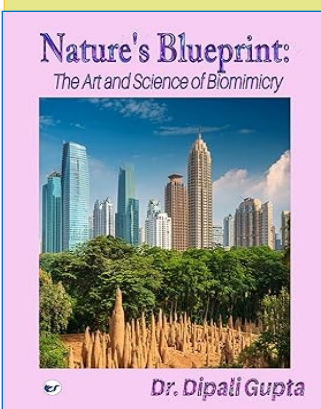
