remind students of the importance of peace, unity, and harmony in society. Students were also encouraged to share their reflections, making the observance a collective moment of remembrance and learning.

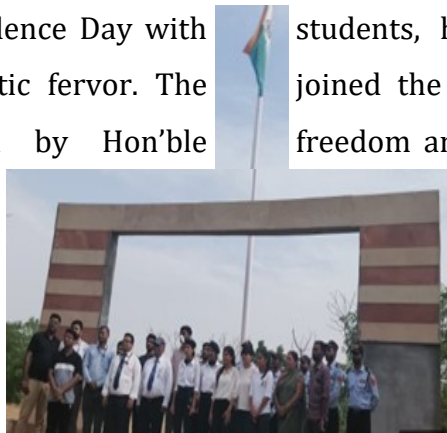
Anti-Ragging Week Observed
