This year, the 4th edition of the festival was held from 14th to 18th March, 2019 in Bikaner at four different places.

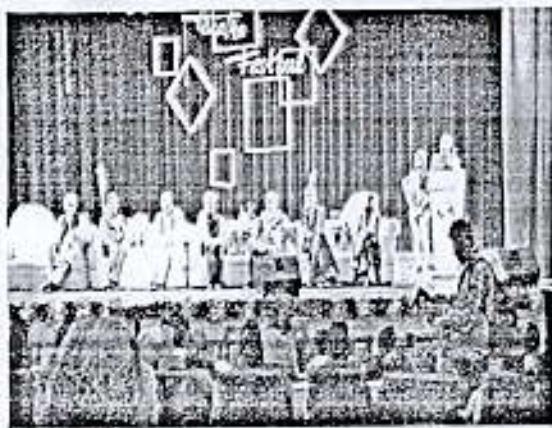
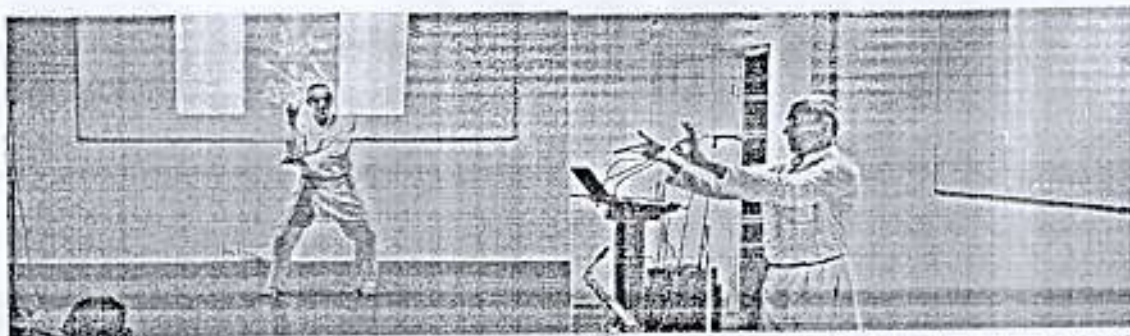
This festival was started in 2016 by the prestigious cultural non-for-profit organization "Anurag Kala Kendra". The festival is a magnificent hub of audiences and Theatre performances from all over the country. First started in 2016, this was a 5-day festival held in the cultural capital of Rajasthan that hosts regional, national, independent and experimental works of contemporary Theatre. This year, festival was hosting more than 15 premier plays in 7 different languages like Punjabi, Malayalam, Konkani, Assamees, Rajasthani, Marathi and Hindustani.

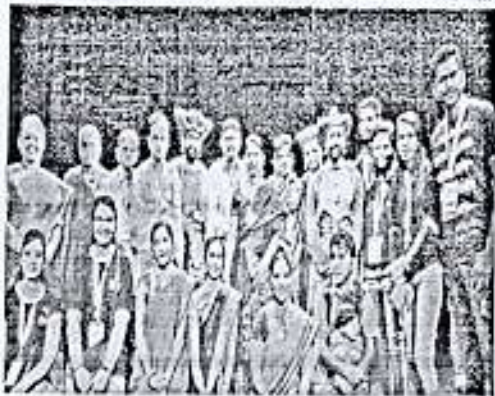

Speaker TM Lalani told that this time the Bikaner Theater Festival has been grand and entertaining. This time this festival was dedicated to Dr. Nand Kishor Acharya, a renowned name, famous for his varied forms of theatre plays.

During All 5 Days the BTF 4 celebrity visited our University. Detail are following

1. **Ms. Sanjana Kapoor** : Co-founder & Director. Sanjna spearheads the Arts at Play for Schools programme, loves the sheer energy and excitement of the arts and is brilliant at curating this for eager audiences. She instigated the creation of the India Theatre Forum (ITF) because she was feeling lonely, and is currently part of the core team as well as a core team member and facilitator for SMART - Strategic Management in the Art of Theatre. Many of you will remember her for building Prithvi Theatre into a warm, inviting cultural hub, some of you will remember her for her earnest Amul India Show questioning, and some of you apparently loved her in Hero Hiralal - a confession which never fails to embarrass her. She believes in multi-tasking, and will one day possibly achieve being in multiple places at once - so that she can always be with theatre and always be with her son at one and the same time. When you don't find her messing about with the arts, you'll probably find her in the jungles of Africa or scuba-diving in some beautiful ocean somewhere, talking to the manta-rays.

2. **Ashok Banthia**- Famous by the name Ashok Banthia is a Hindi film actor as well as director. Ashok was born in Udaipur in a traditional business family. In the year 1932, after earning a diploma in theatre and dramatics from Punjab University, Chandigarh, Ashok went to the National School of Drama in New Delhi followed by a course in the direction at the National Institute of Dramatic Arts (NIDA), in Sydney.

3. **Michel Lestrehan**- Demonstration of Kathakalli He is Experiences with contemporary choreographers in Paris from 1977 (Carolyn Carlson, Karine Saporta, Yano Hideyuki) Michel Lestréhan entered into the Indian dance in 1984 with Kathak in Ahmedabad with Kumudini Lakhia and Arjun Mishra. After one year, he went to Kerala where he was fascinated by the Kathakali dance-theater. He started to study in Kerala Kalamandalam with great master Vazhenkada Vijayan. He returned to Kerala in 1987 for six years to continue the practice of Kathakali in Kalamandalam, and then with Sadanam Krishnankutty. All these years were under the support of Indo-French Cultural Exchange scholarships. Beside Kathakali, Michel practiced also Kalaripayatt martial art in P.K.B. Kalari Sangham with Balan Gurukkal. In India, Michel was participating in Kalamandalam's troupe for programs, and performed several major roles of Kathakali in India and Europe. He organizes also regular tours with great Kathakali artists. His research is based on his early experiences with Western contemporary dance and the inspiration from Indian techniques. He worked on several choreographic pieces, mainly with Indian dancers and musicians.

4. **Bishoy Aniyam**- Bamboo & Saxophone Performance - Famous Music composer, who had also worked at Mathalam: A Ethnic Music Band amazed the audience with his classical flute and saxophone performance.

NSS Unit was honoured and feels privileged to make Blood Donation an annual event of celebration.

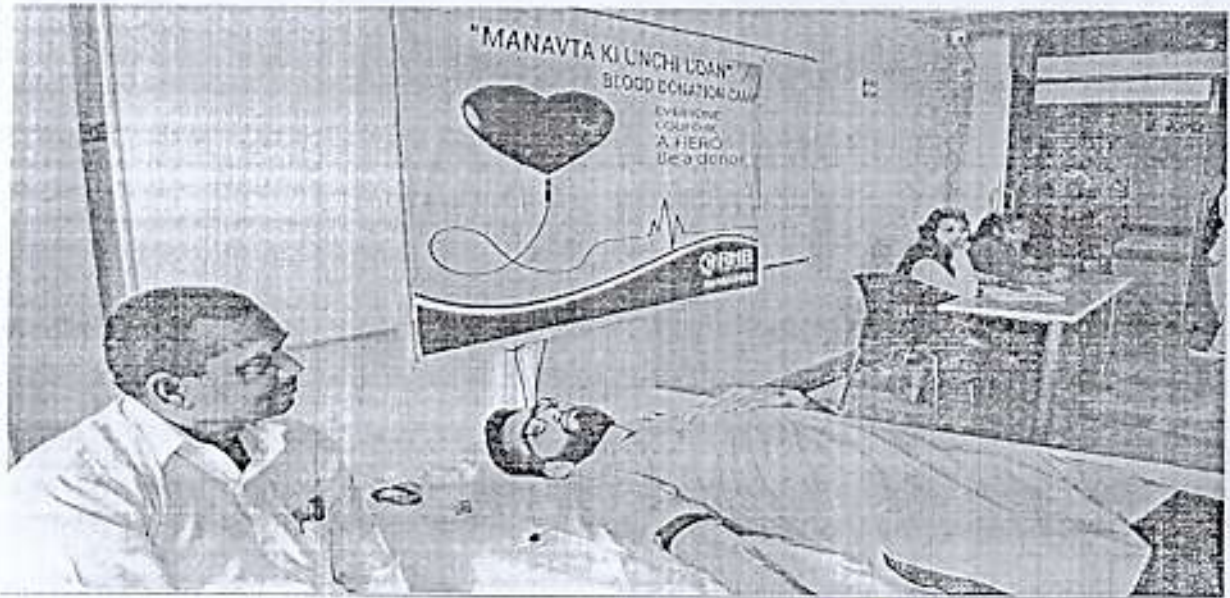
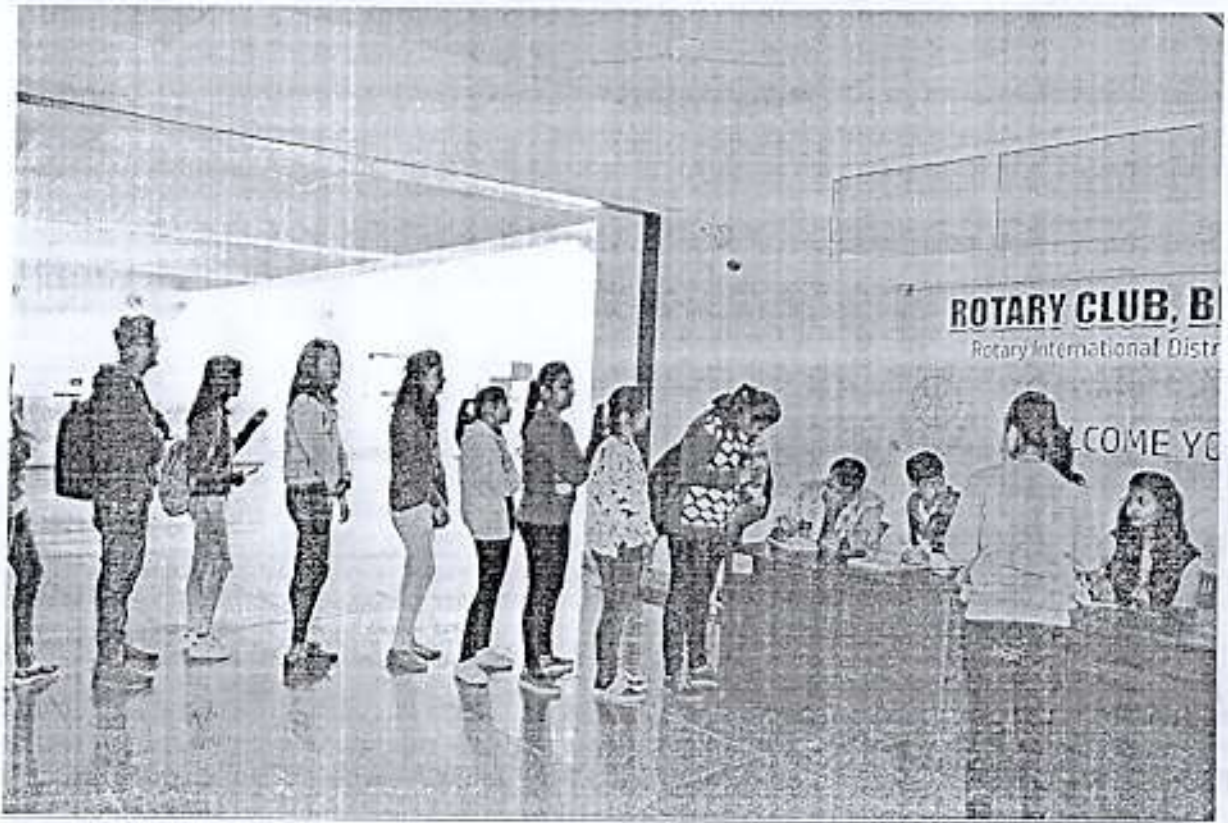

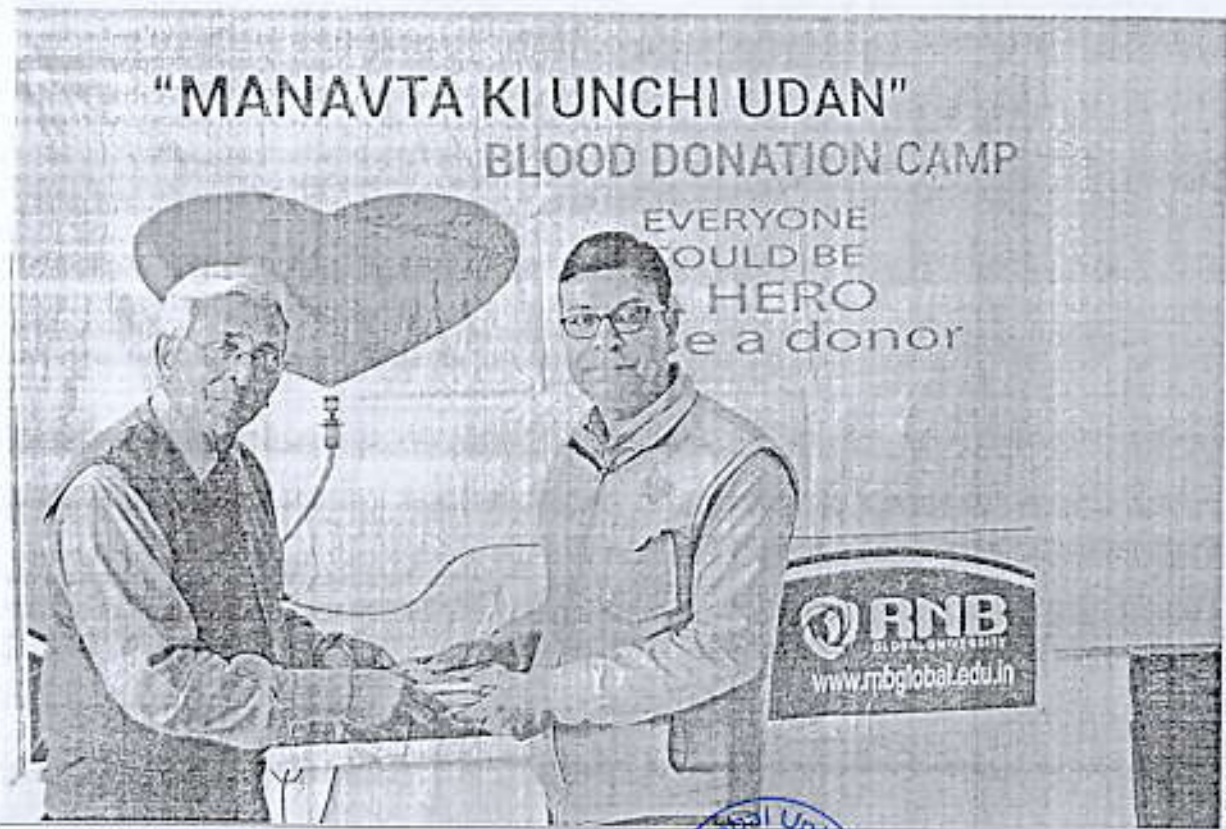

In continuation of human endeavour by RNB Global University, a free dental check-ups and awareness camp was organized at University campus. Dr. Vaibhav Sachdev and Dr. Rachna Sachdev along with Para-medical staff carried out a comprehensive dental check-up for the students and staff members of the University.


The camp was initiated with dental awareness talk, educating students about common dental ailments, especially stressing on tooth decay and gum diseases and measures to prevent from them. The students were highlighted about the eating patterns and food choices which cause tooth decay. The surgeons also highlighted about the possible formation of harmful acid which develops when bacteria (plaque) get in contact with sugar in the mouth which ultimately results in tooth decay.

The students got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral diseases. On completion of the dental check-up each student was given a Patient Card, a report summary of the diagnosed problem and the recommended dental treatment plan.

## A Report on 4th Free legal awareness camp organized by Law Students at Khara

### Introduction

A legal awareness camp was organized at Khara Village by the members of School of Law, RNB Global University, Bikaner. The objective of this camp was to establish good relationship with the people of village so that they could openly discuss their issues and to inform the dalit people of the area about the SC/ST Act and their rights associated with it.

Students of School of Law discussed about Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan and importance of such missions in the development of the country. They also discussed various issues like rights of a detained person, right to be taken before a magistrate without delay; Rights of speedy trial, Right to consult a legal practitioner, Dowry Prohibition Act, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in which they discussed about what remedies are open to a person belonging to scheduled caste or scheduled tribe in case they are facing any type of atrocities, whom to approach for such remedy, and how to realize these remedies.

This was the initial and a very small step towards the cause; again with the assistance of NGOs and local authorities a more positive and long lasting impact can be created. Also if we can include someone from the community in planning and organizing of the program it would have better acceptability among people. The response of the people was heartwarming; it was great to see how receptive people were towards such a sensitive issue. The task is not complete yet as one program cannot create desired impact. Persistent efforts will only help the cause.
