Introduction:

Legal Aid Committee, School of Law organized a Legal Aid Camp in the Village of Dandusar (Rajasthan). The main aim of the camp was to enlighten the people of Village about free legal services to the poor and needy who cannot afford the services of a lawyer for the conduct of a case or a legal proceeding in any court.

Mr. Shubham Singh, Student of BBA-LLB-V semester, discussed about rights of a detained person, right to know the grounds of detention, right to be taken before a magistrate without delay; Rights of speedy trial and right to consult a legal practitioner. Ms. Sakshi Sharma, Student of BBA-LLB-V semester gave idea to them about the Dowry Prohibition Act in which she discussed that How giving and taking dowry has been made prohibited by law and what remedies are open to a person in case of getting compelled to pay dowry. Ms. Harshita, Student of LLB-IV semester gave an idea about the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in which she discussed about what remedies are open to a person belonging to scheduled caste or scheduled tribe in case they are facing any type of atrocities, whom to approach for such remedy, and how to realise these remedies.

Objectives:

- To make them aware about the legal aid services.
- To increase law awareness among the society.

Brief About the Visit:

Legal Aid Cell of RNB Global University School of Law organised a Legal Aid Camp at Village Dandusar on 23.12.2022, where they dealt with issues which a child, goes through in a daily course of life. In an interactive session, the students briefed them about various topics such as Fundamental Rights, Consumer Protection Rights, Traffic Rules and Duties, Cyber Crimes, Child Abuse, Human Rights and some other topics related to daily lives. Villagers including farmers, business men, young boys, women and children, attended the session. The students made them aware about Rights of Children, Child Labour Act, Right of Children to free and compulsory education and other legislations made for the care,



protection and development of children and different schemes launched by NALSA and RLSA for the benefit of people.

The aim of this legal Aid camp was to enlighten the people on about various Law in our System and their importance and to provide the legal assistance. It was an absolute delight to have such Legal Aid camps for increasing the law awareness among the Society.

A group of 32 students from RNB Global University actively participated in all the activities of the camp which were conducted to spread awareness regarding the Basic Rights.

On 12.12.2021, students of School of law visited Village Dandusar Bikaner between 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. students were informed priorly & equipped with a questionnaire for better understanding of the real situation of the village with the following objectives of the Visit:

1. Issue: Lack of knowledge about the basic rights among the adults as well as children's of Village.
2. Impact: Increased Protection risks (e.g. parents pulling children from school or resorting to child marriage)
3. Action: to discuss the issue and proposed solutions with the community
4. Goal: To develop and implement new, effective interventions with the community

Activities of the camp:

In order to spread awareness amongst the students regarding issues involving the basic rights and enabling them to tackle problems existing and rising in the society, the students of the RNB Global University along with the assistance of the committee members commenced the first activity of the camp with the Teaching Programme. The students from classes 2-10 of Dandusar School were taught about the following aspects:

Fundamental Rights

Right to Information Act, 2002

Consumer Protection Act, 1986.



They were also introduced to various career options available to them. The classes were not only engaging but also very informative to the students. Later the students went on a Rally throughout the village shouting various slogans to create awareness among the villagers pertaining to Right to Education, Property Rights, Swachh Bharat etc. Through this initiative the villagers were not only

The program effectively addressed the legal issues and was marked by the excitement of the residents of the village who actively participated in activities conducted for them informed about their rights.

The inhabitants had a good understanding about consumer rights, right to information and women's right in ancestral property. The villagers have reasonable amount of knowledge regarding Lok Adalat. Even though they have knowledge about Swachh Bharat and other governmental schemes they were not making use of those schemes. Sadly, women and senior citizens have very less legal knowledge.

Report on Untouchability:

Introduction:

RNB Global University, Bikaner has organized a village visit to village Husangsar and students of BBA IV Sem RNB Global University has participated in it.

More than 160 million people in India are considered "Untouchable" - people tainted by their birth into a caste system that deems them impure, less than human.

Untouchable, most of the world assumes that something sin- Mahatma Gandhi, modernization, progressive legislation - has solved this ancient Indian problem or reduced it to marginal significance. There has been some progress, but for each of the past several years, official figures on violent attacks against Untouchables have routinely exceeded 10,000 cases. Indian human rights workers report that most cases go unrecorded.

Background: About Husangsar:

Husangsar village is located in Bikaner tehsil of Bikaner district in Rajasthan, India. It is situated 20km away from Bikaner, which is both district & sub-district headquarter of Husangsar village. As per 2009 stats, Husangsar village is also a gram panchayat. The total geographical area of village is 1886 hectares. Husangsar has a total population of 1,591 peoples, out of which male population is 829 while female population is 762. Literacy rate of husangsar village is 43.68% out of which 52.47% males and 34.12% females are literate. There are about 247 houses in husangsar village.

About the Visit:

The Village Visit Programme is a very important component of the Course, wherein the field visit is taken out of the confines of the classrooms and are exposed to the realities and complexities of rural life.



Objectives:

1. Assess the socio-economic-political dynamics that exist in a village;
2. Understand and analyse the problems faced by the rural people especially the marginalized sections such as Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, physically challenged, old, poor, landless and women, etc.;

Contact with the People

The first activity which has undertaken on arrival in the village is to establish contact with the people. The usual persons to be contacted are the elected people such as village Pradhan, the school teacher, the office bearers of the Panchayat, the NGO representatives, the village shopkeeper, the village doctor/ the RMP, the serving and retired government personnel, the Anganwadi Sevika, etc. These persons represent the formal power structure of the rural society.

Theories of modern villagers are often more hazy, but belief in the innately and legitimately inferior status of Untouchables is no less strong; similar attitudes often surface among sophisticated urbanites. During recent riots against special access rules for Untouchables to professional schools, a leading sociologist wrote angrily of cases in which qualified Untouchable applicants to medical schools were told to go back to being sweepers.

The cultural denigration of Untouchables has long had important economic implications. Untouchability, like racism in the Western world, has served to rationalize and maintain a vast pool of cheap labor. It has also limited competition for those goods and positions that have defined power and prestige, whatever these have been over the years - land, the priesthood, modern white-collar professions. In protesting their status. Untouchables challenge the high degree of self-interest and deeply ingrained social beliefs that permeate Hindu society. Increasingly, the Untouchables have insisted on rising above this institution.



Conclusion:

Overall, it can be said that the visit was an exceptionally viable and instructing one, through really good assistance by the professors and village heads. The students learnt plenty about the various hardships confronted and the fact that resources are, indeed scarce. Thus, it will be really helpful if the necessary aid is provided to these villagers to help them come out of their struggles and lead, at least, a decent life with lesser shortcomings.

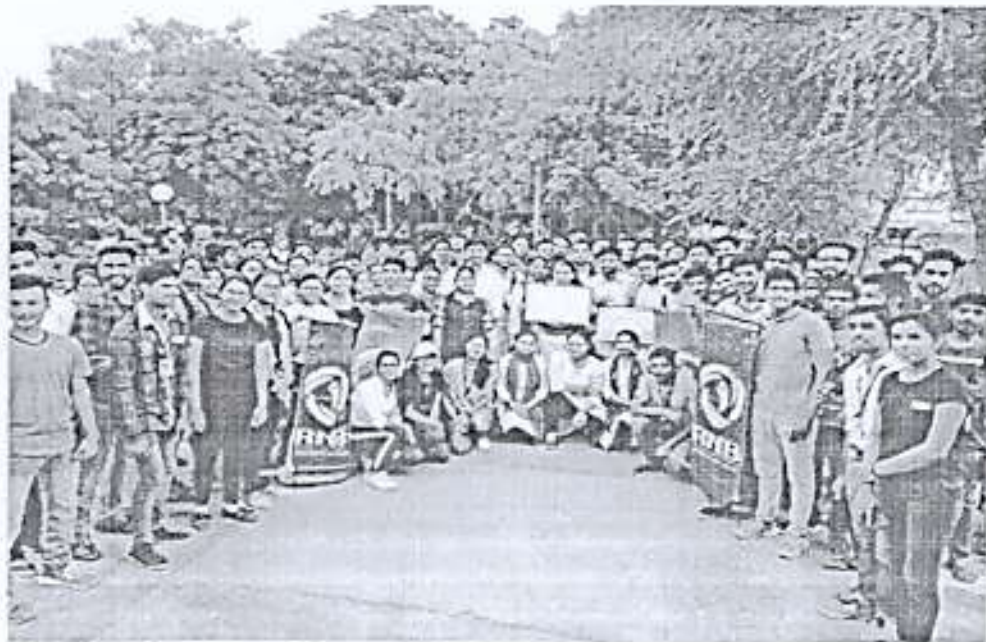


Conclusion:

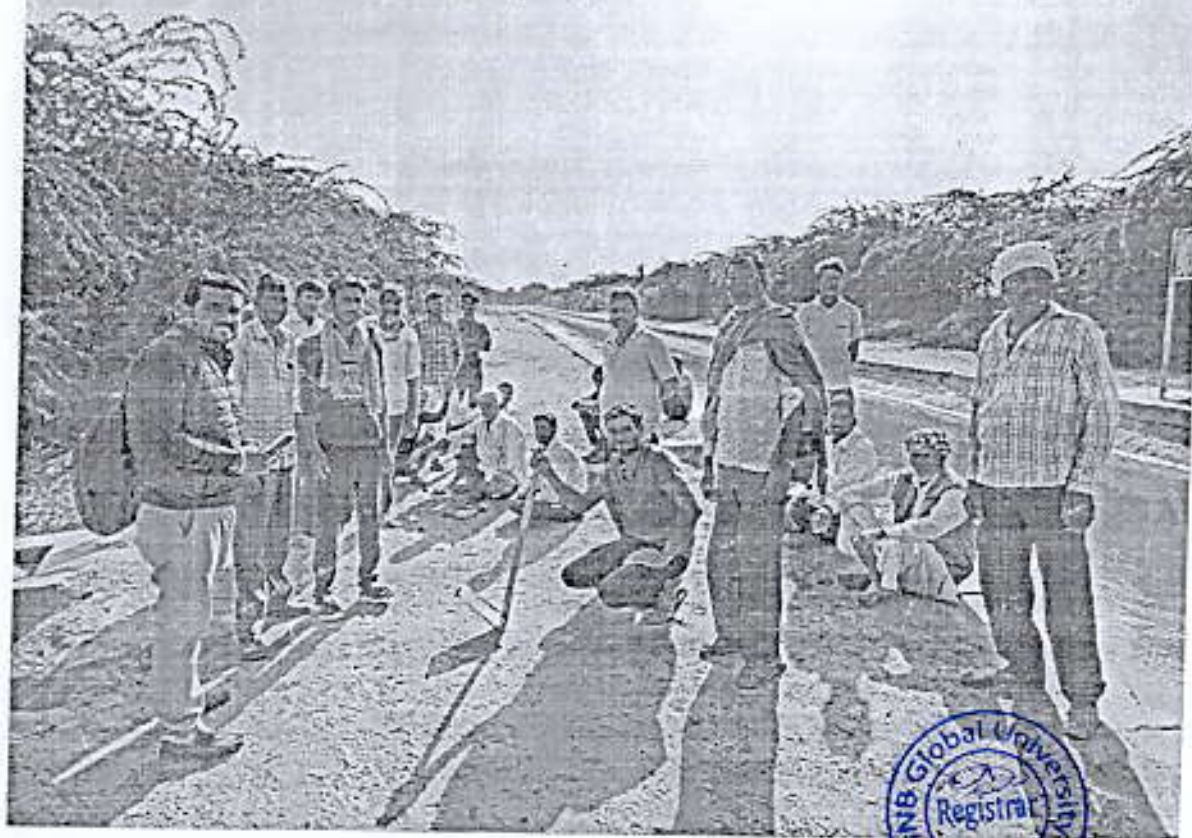

Introduction:

RNB Global University has started a Campaign with a hashtag #I WILL DO MY CITY CLEAN". Students were told to do many activities like inspection, cleanliness near the surrounding areas etc.

Dengue Symptoms

Disease occurs more frequently in the rainy season and immediately afterwards (July to November) in India..

Fever: continuous for 3 to 7 days, Severe headache, Joint pain, muscle pain, pain behind eyeballs Nausea, vomiting, and rashes on skin.

In very rare cases, the condition may worsen into dengue hemorrhagic fever, leads to bleeding from nose, gums, in urine and from internal organs.

Suggestions for People:

- Don't allow water to remain stagnant in and around your house.
- Fill the ditches.
- Clean the blocked drains.
- Empty the room air coolers and flower vases completely at least once in seven days and then refill them.
- Tray below the fridge also to be cleaned regularly.
- Dispose off old containers tins and tyres etc. Properly.
- Keep the water tanks and water containers tightly covered so that the mosquitoes can not enter them and start breeding.
- Keep the surroundings of your house clean.
- Don't litter garbage.
- Don't allow wild herbs etc. to grow around your house.
- Spray insecticidal sprays behind the photo frames, curtains, calendars, corners of house and stores. Use insecticidal sprays in all areas within the house at-least once a week.



Conclusions:

RNB GLOBAL University took initiative in Dengue Awareness and Precaution activities in the campus as well as outside the campus. Efforts were taken to control breeding of mosquitoes by removing stagnant water and sprinkling disinfectant in the areas.



5th Bikaner Theatre Festival – BTF 2020


This year, the 5th edition of the festival was held from 04th to 08th March, 2020 in Bikaner at eight different places (Venue).
