

3. Oral presentation

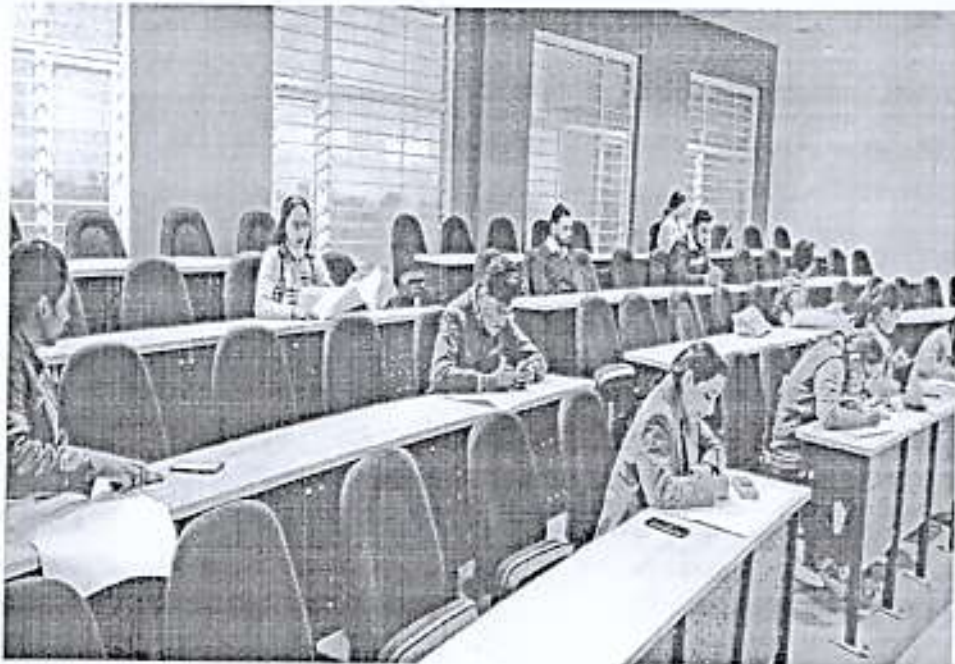

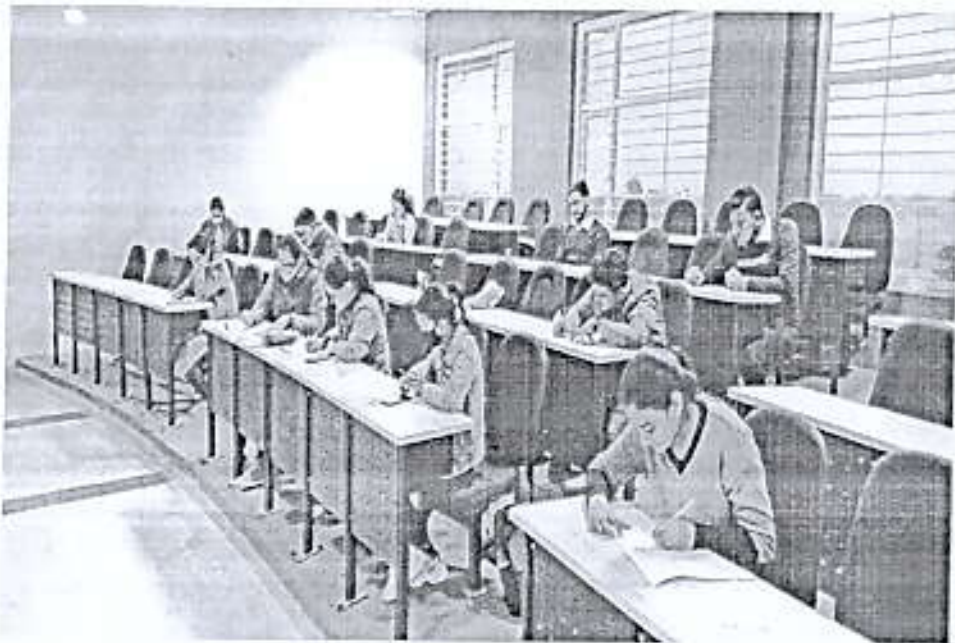

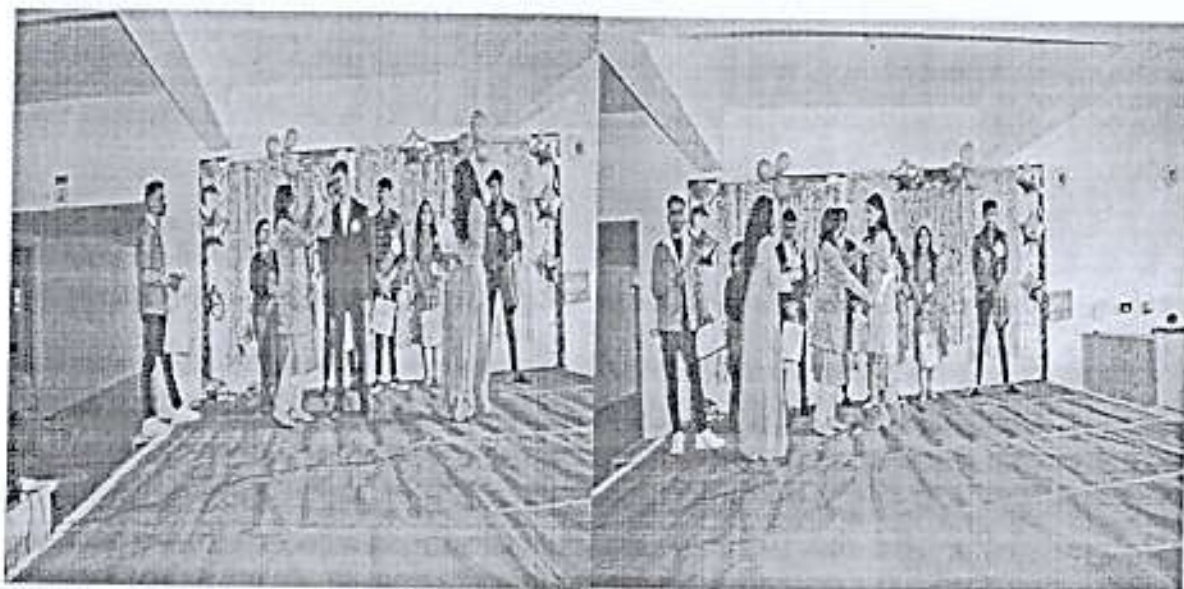

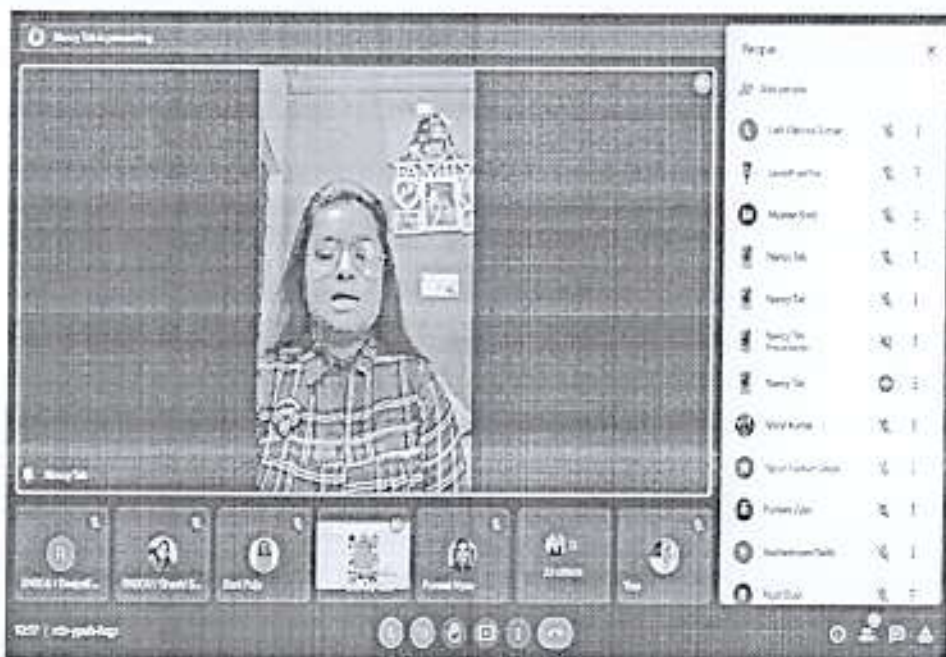

There were fourteen (14) participants in the quiz. Ms. Akanksha Mohata, (BBA V sem) won the quiz.

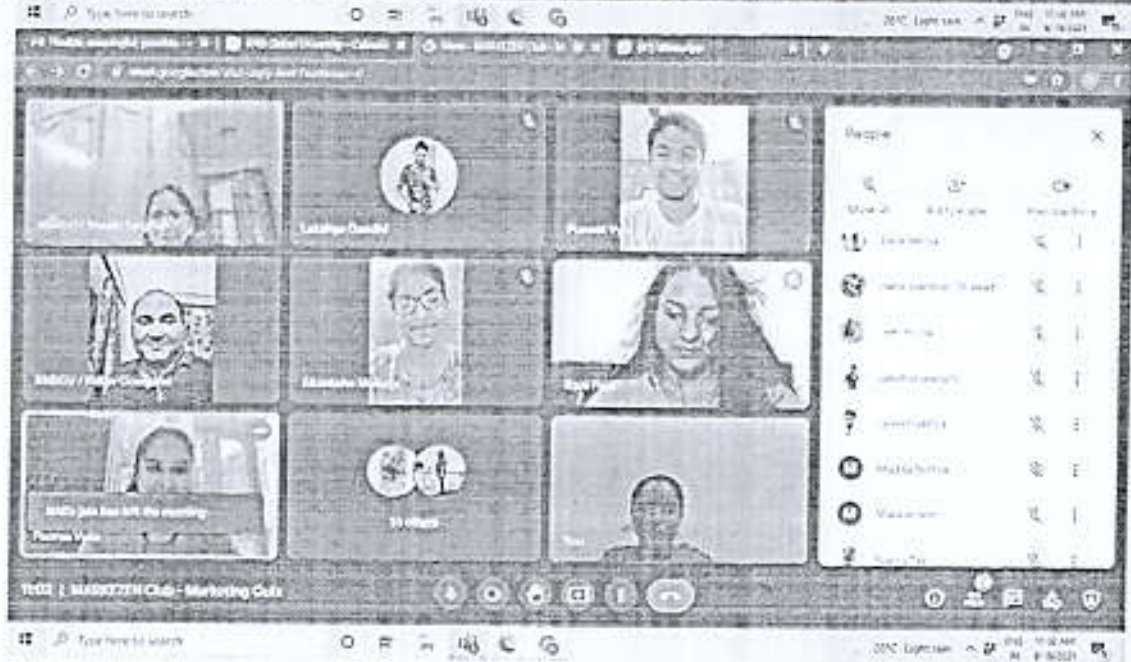
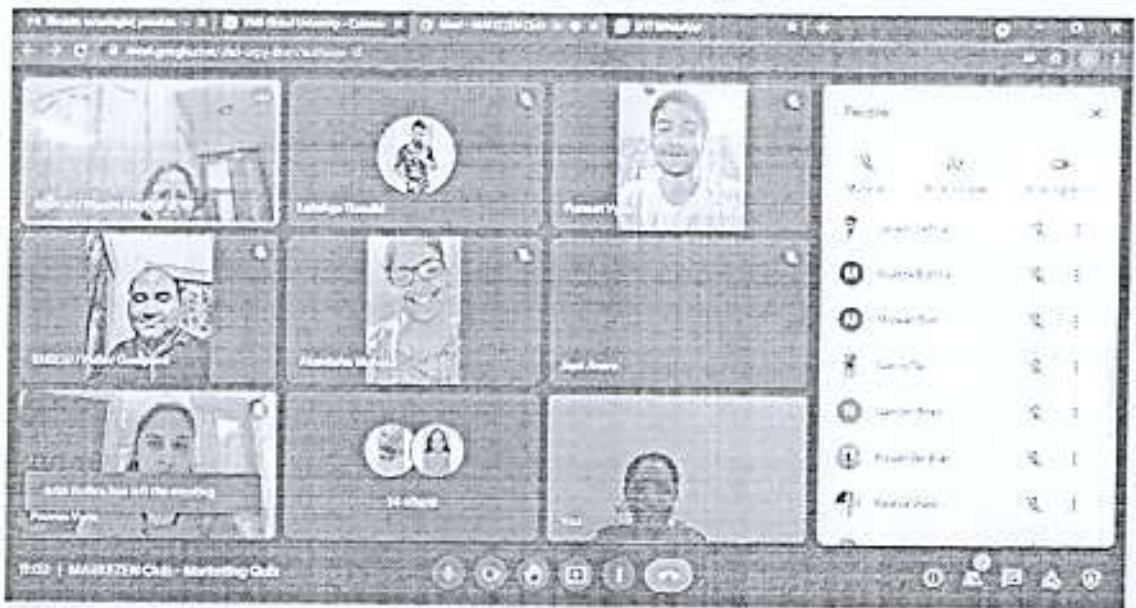
