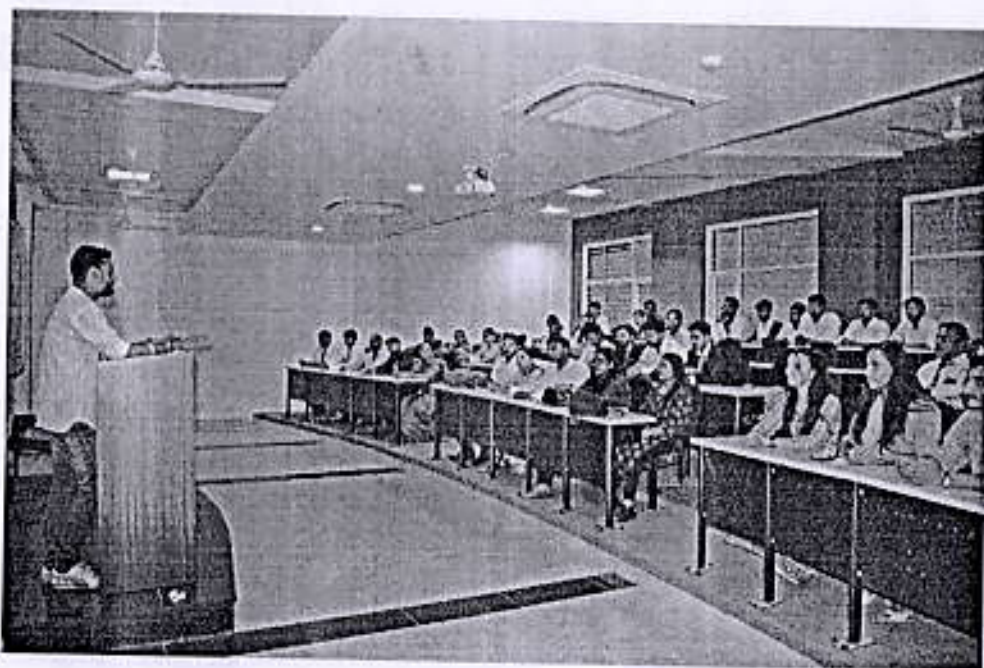

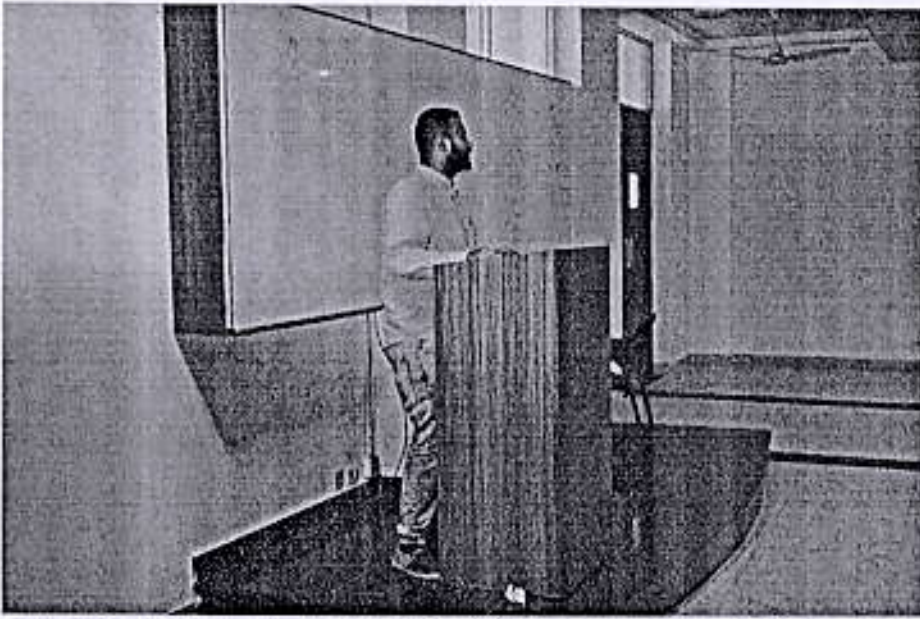

Student Interaction in School of Law

Date:15.12.2020

The Surrogacy (Regulation) Bill, 2019 and the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Bill, 2020 received approval from the Rajya Sabha on Wednesday. These two measures would regulate the use of surrogacy and other reproductive technologies in India.

Students of School of Law need to be aware about the changes or amendments that are happening in the law domain. For the purpose alumni extended a learning hand and visited university to discuss about Surrogacy Bill. Mr. Yashpal Renua, he is currently practicing with the Advocate having expertise in Surrogacy Bill & Ms. Manisha Kalyana, she is also currently practicing with the Advocate.

Mr. Yashpal, discussed about the main goal of the legislation is to forbid commercial surrogacy and only permit altruistic surrogacy. The bill defines altruistic surrogacy as a type of adoption in which the intended parents pay the surrogate mother's medical costs but nothing else. Commercial surrogacy is defined as surrogacy that involves the sale or purchase of a human child and is prohibited in the nation under this legislation.

Ms. Manish stated that, the bill also specifies qualifying requirements for the surrogate mother and the couple choosing surrogacy. A "certificate of essentiality" is required of



the couple in question, which must include a proof of infertility for one or both of the parties, a court order establishing the parentage and custody of the child conceived through surrogacy, and insurance coverage for the surrogate mother for 16 months, including post-partum complications.

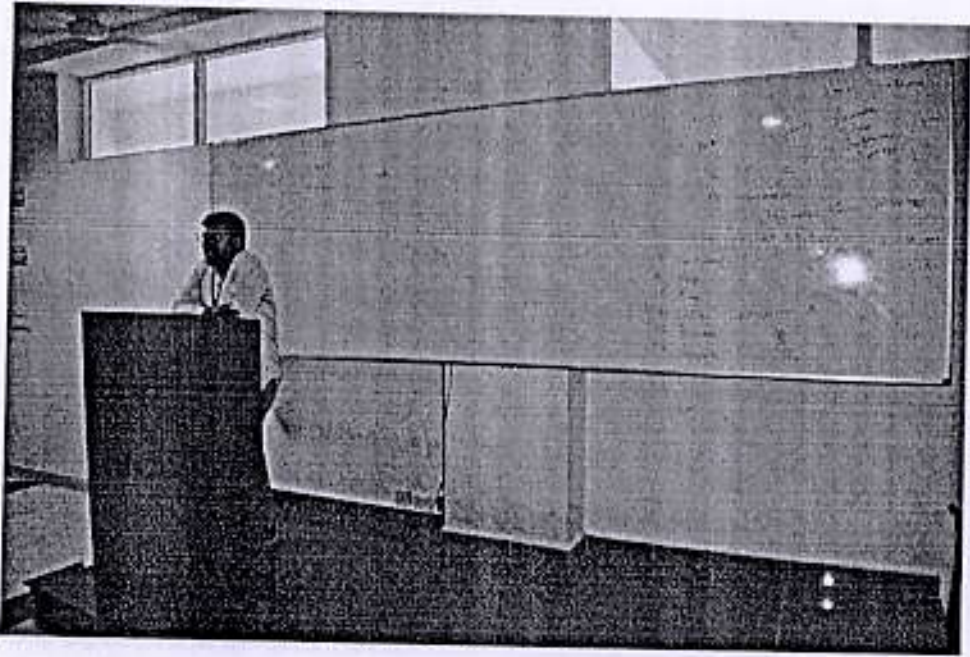

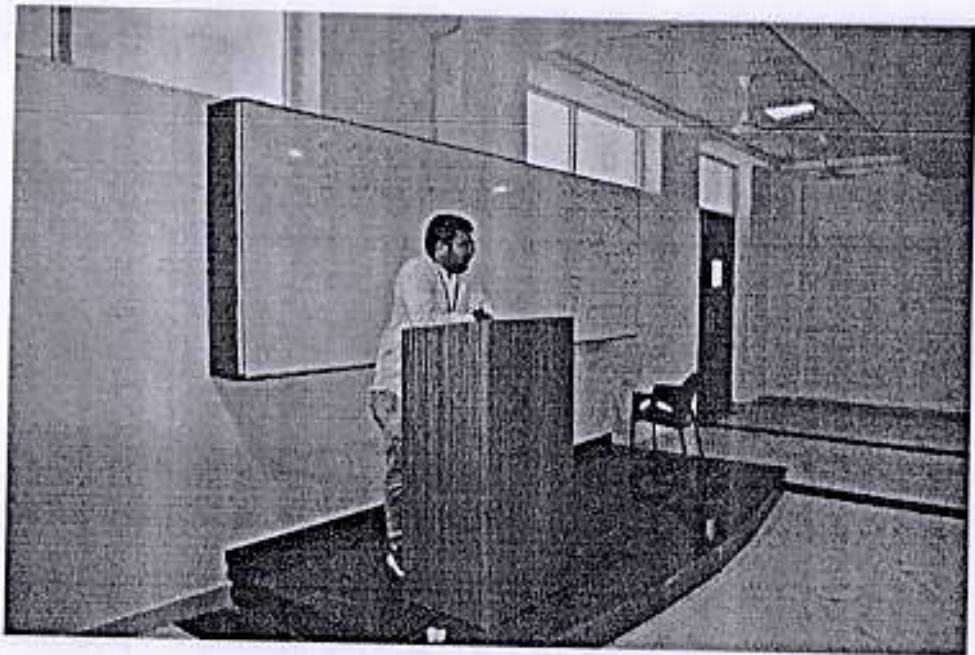

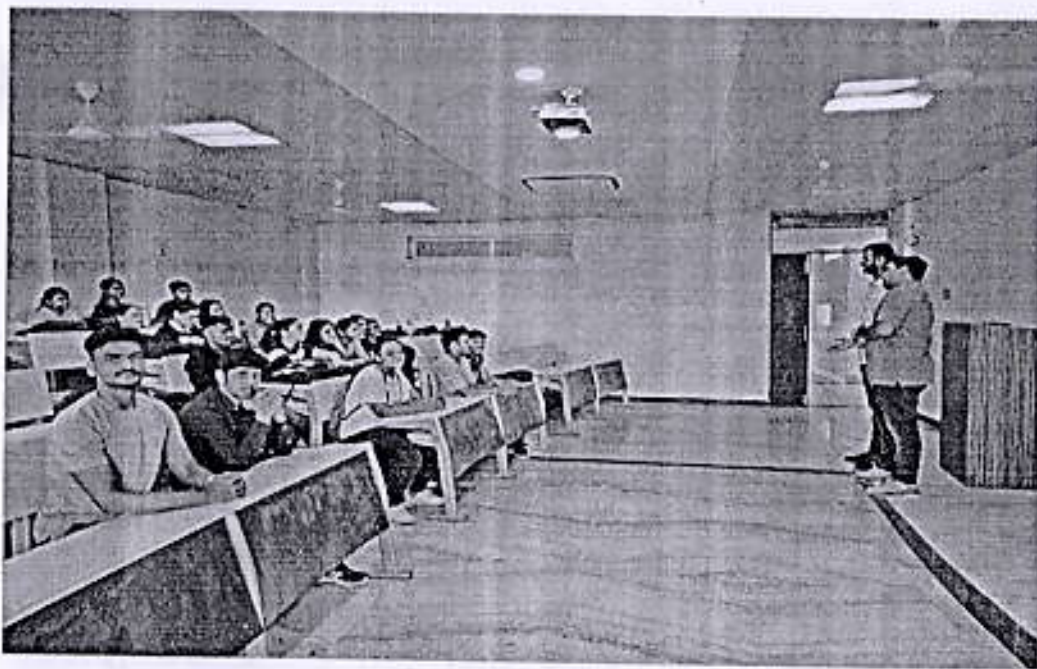
