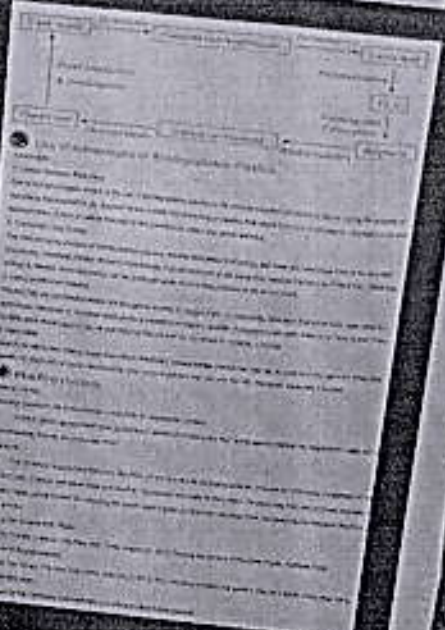
ABSTRACT

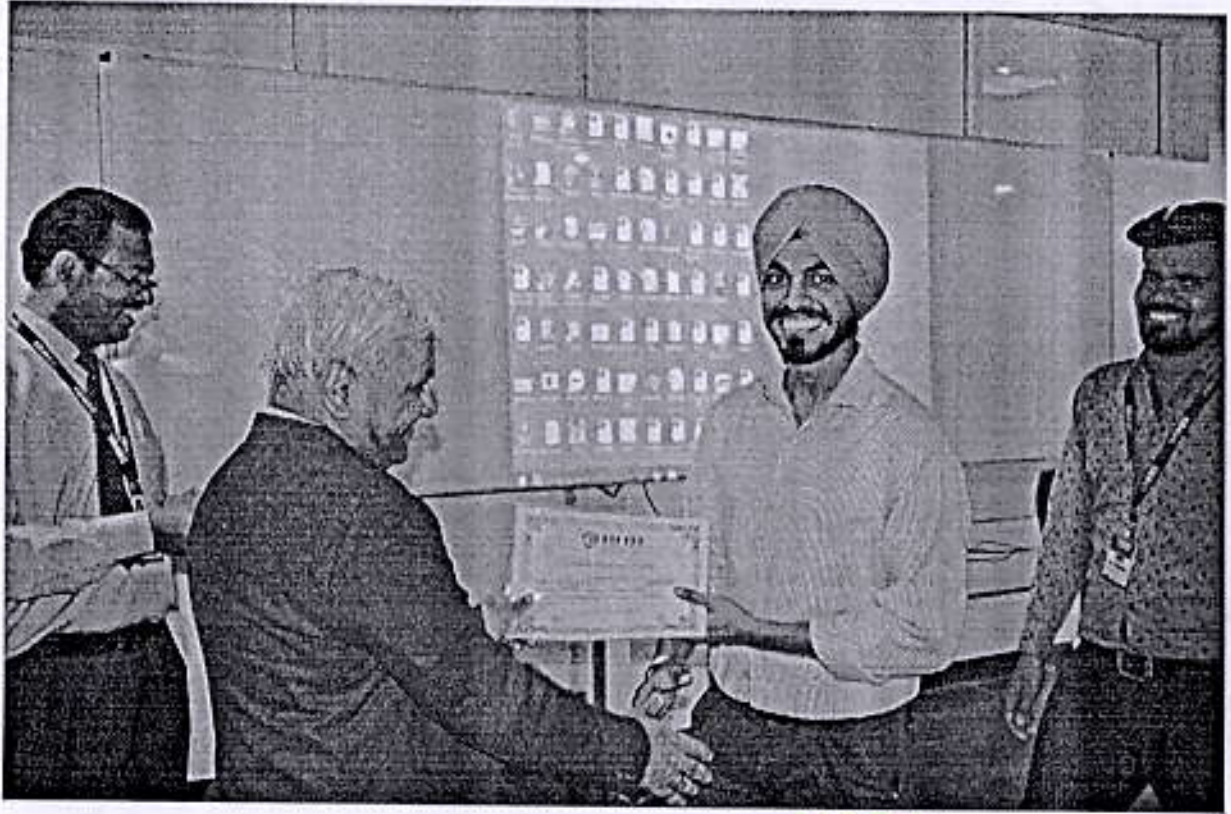
Introduction

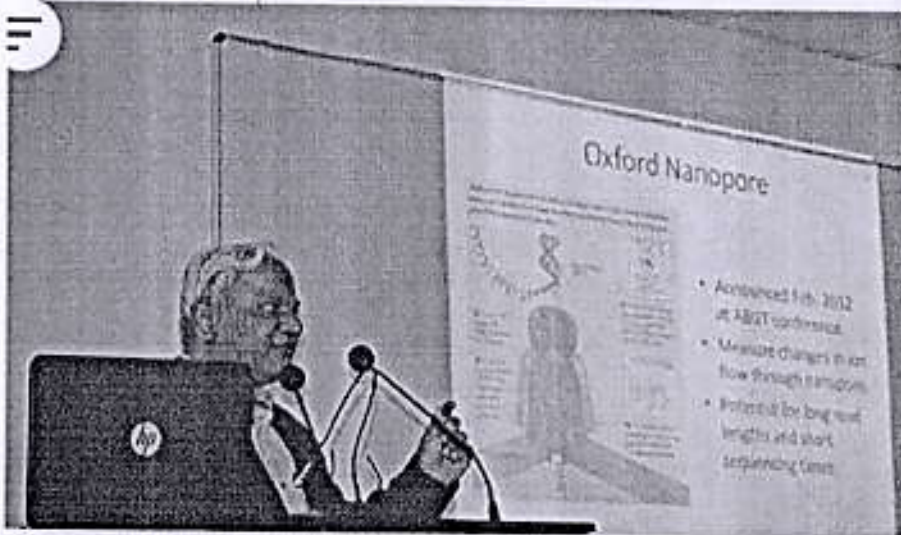
Methodology

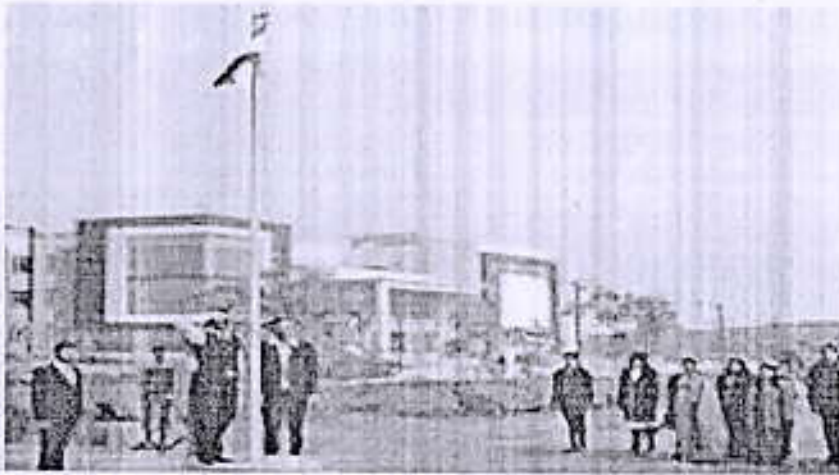

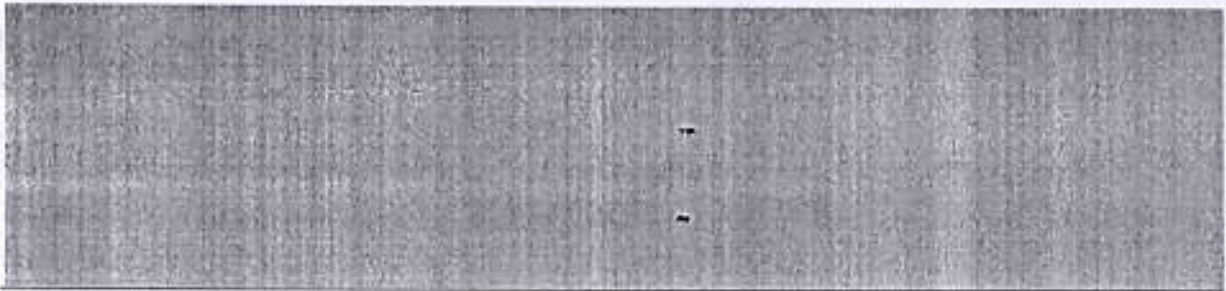

People from government as well as non government organizations take part in the functions and camps related to the Legal Services Day.

71st Independence Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm and Feeling of patriotism at RNB Global University. To mark the importance of this day a grand celebration was held in the university.

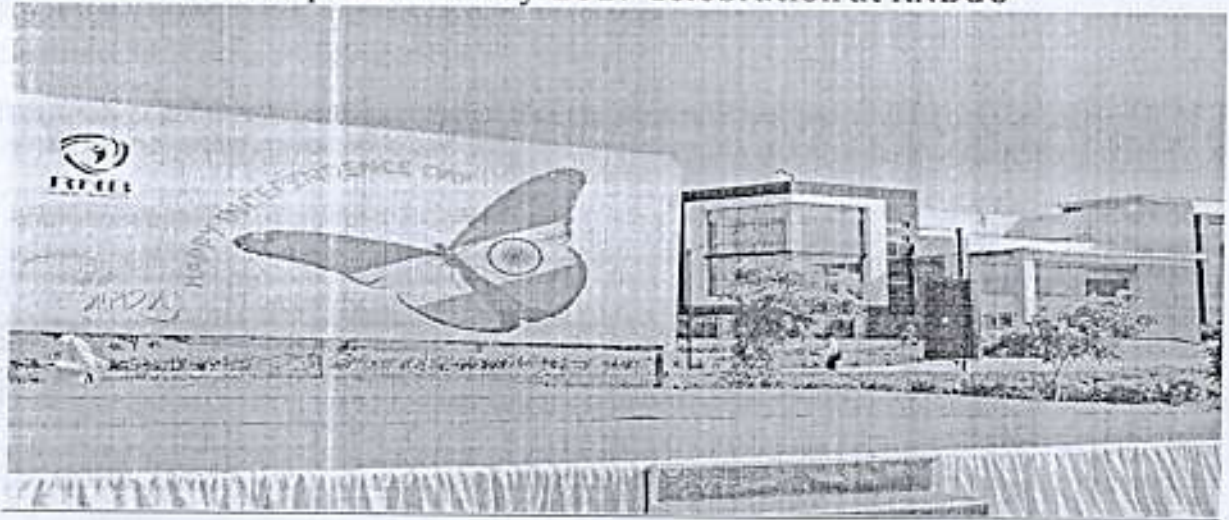

Such events set a great start for the new session and motivate students to actively participate in such events also in future.

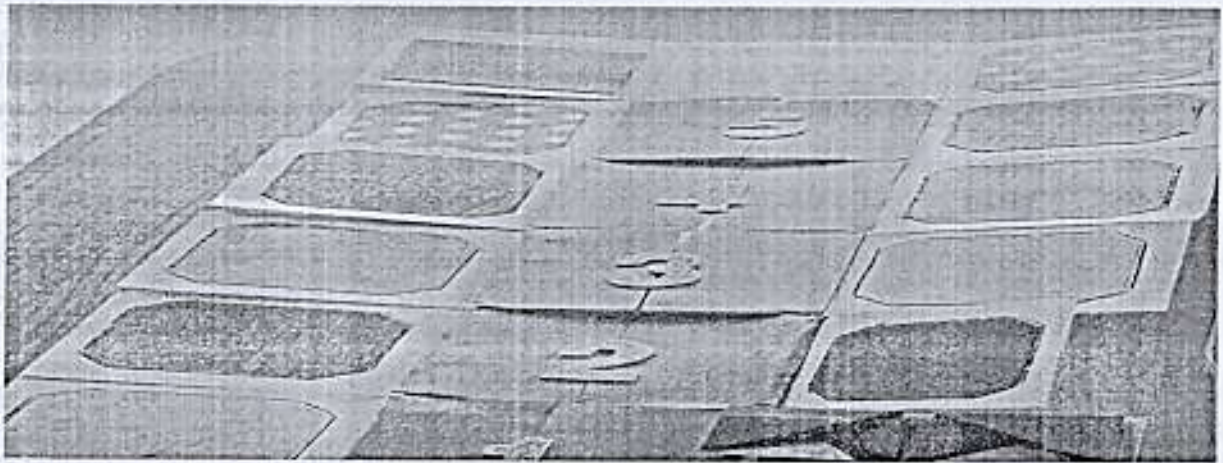

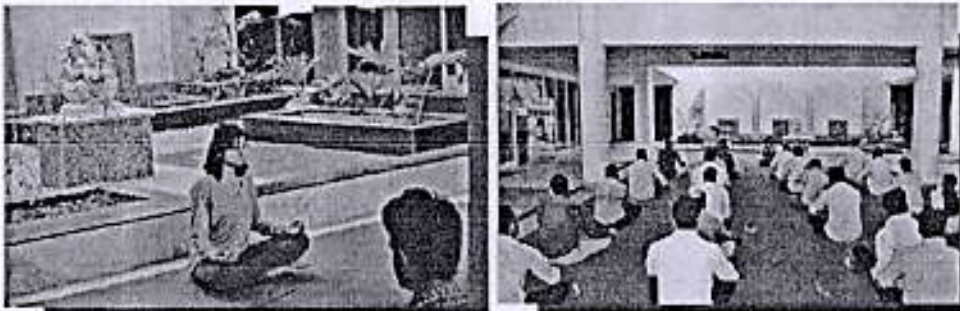
