Holi, the Festival of Colours was celebrated with great enthusiasm at RNB Global University on the 19th March 2019.



Raman who was the first scientist to be honoured by Nobel Prize in the Subject of Physics in 1930. In 1986, the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the Government of India to designate 28 February as National Science Day and the first National Science Day was celebrated on February 28, 1987.

### Importance

RNBGU celebrated National Science Day on 28th February, 2019 on theme declared by Govt.of India "Science for the people & people for the science". National Science Day was planned to highlight how Science and Technology has touched our every sphere of life. The major idea of the celebration was to discuss how science has made live comfortable along with the implementation of new technologies for the development in the field of science.

### **Technical Session**

The programme was inaugurated with speech by student high-lighting the importance of Raman Effect and its application in present day technologies. Mr. Brij Gopal Vyas, Retd. Superintending Engineer PHED gave Keynote address and explained how science is important to us.

Dr.Shilpi Garg from BITS Pilani gave an innovative presentation on Bio mimicry and explained how characteristics present in plants, animals or in nature has provided new entrepreneurship ideas with economic values e.g. Gecko Climbing Feet, Kingfisher-Inspired Sylles, Frain. She

explained how designers, architects and engineers are taking cues from nature when they set out to create buildings, trains, prosthetics, robots and fashionable accessories.

### Technical Skit

The most entertaining part of the day was the skit performed by the students of B.Sc Biotech, B.Tech and B.Sc. Agri. in which they raised question on Superstitions and beliefs of people and shows how Science removes these disbeliefs from Society.








































# <u>A</u> <u>Report</u> <u>On</u> Republic Day-2019


### Introduction






