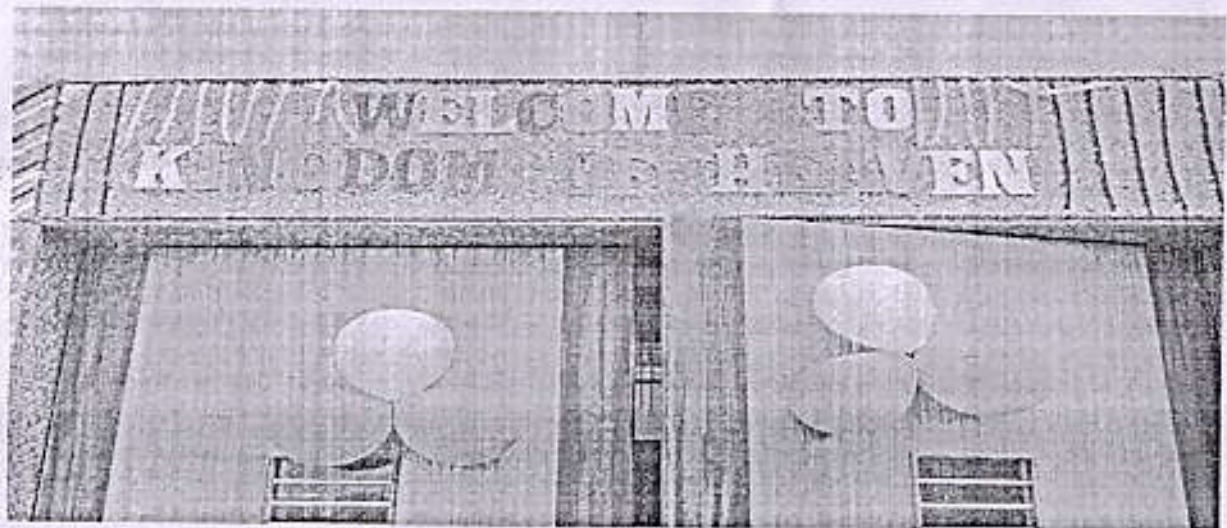
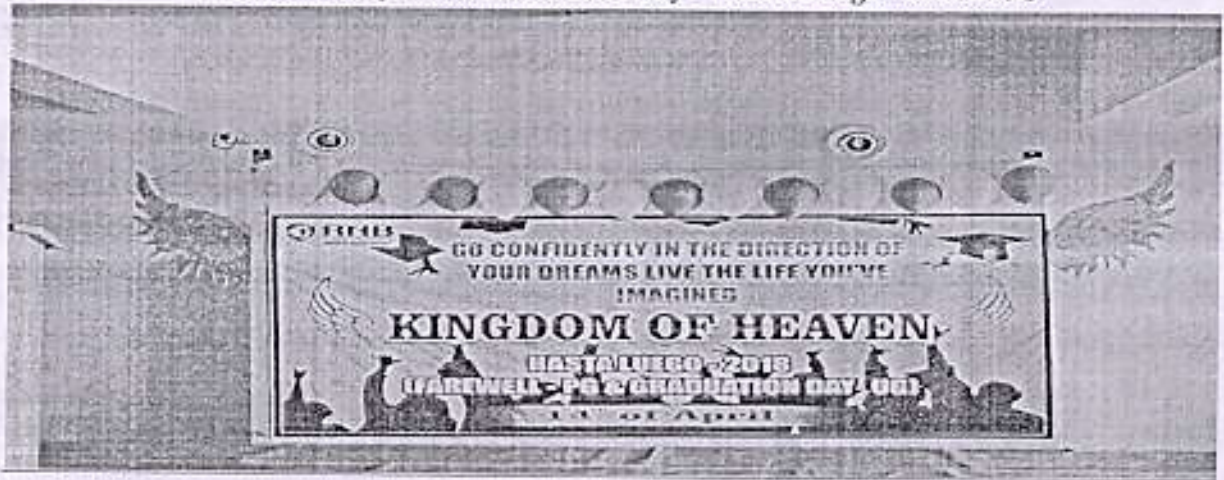

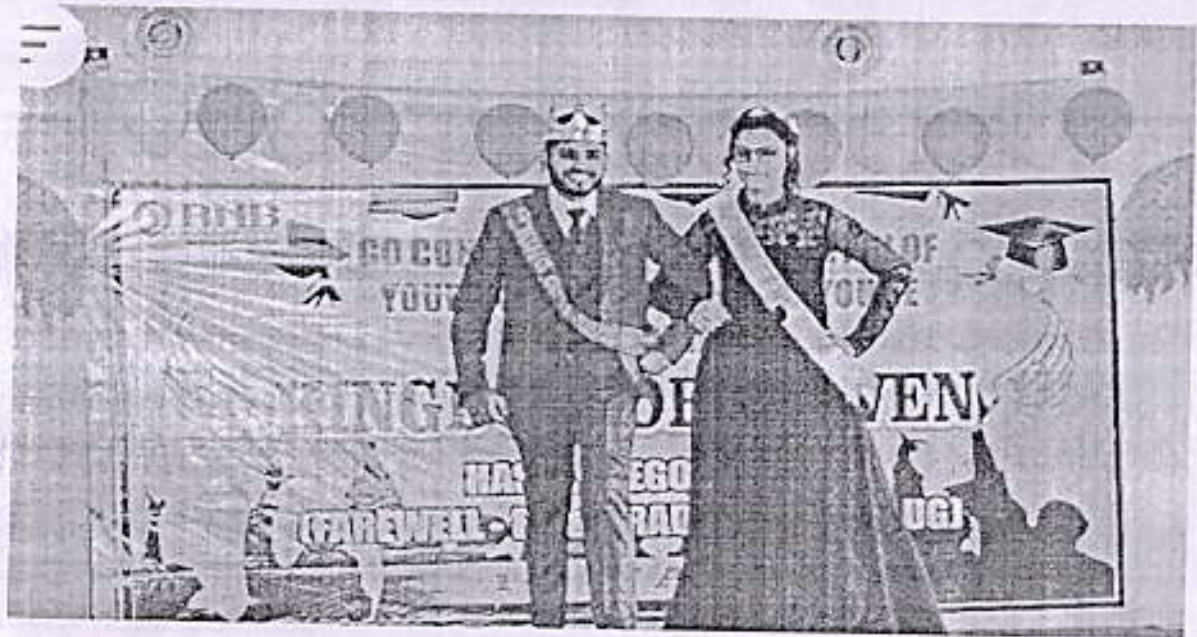

RNB Global University organized Third International Industrial visit to provide an exposure to the students for cross cultural environment. After Dubai visit in 2016 and Malaysia Visit in 2017, this time in 2018, it was Singapore, a sovereign city-state and island country in Southeast Asia. The exciting 4 days trip began with visit of Gourmet East Kitchen is a six-storey industrial complex with 205 units suitable for food-related trades where they learned many managerial concepts.

Students also visited Universal Studios, Southeast Asia's first and only Universal Studios theme park, featuring 24 rides, shows and attractions in seven themed zones. Light-Camera-Action (Special effects show), Transformer ride, Roller coaster ride, Water world show, the mummy ride & Jurassic park caught student's attention over there.

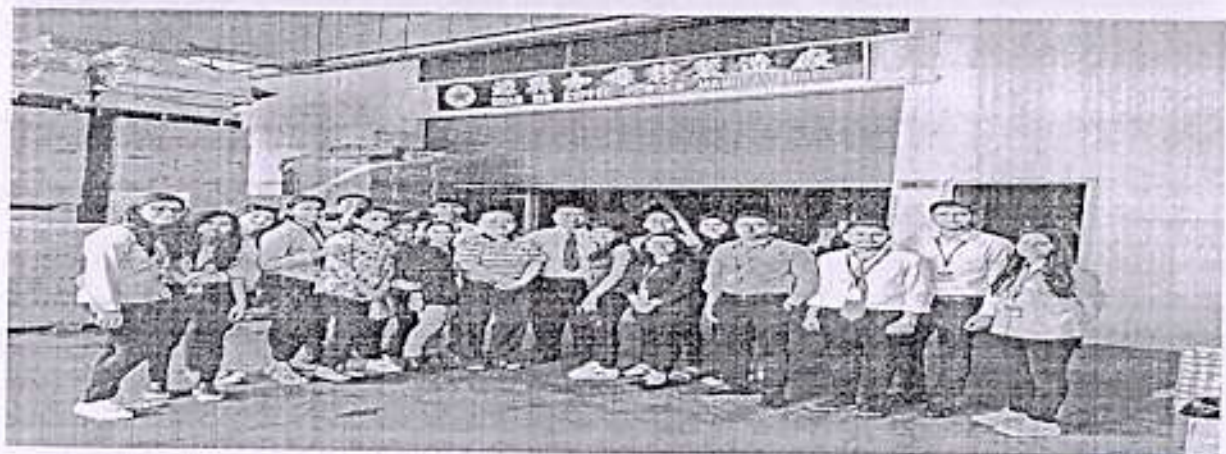

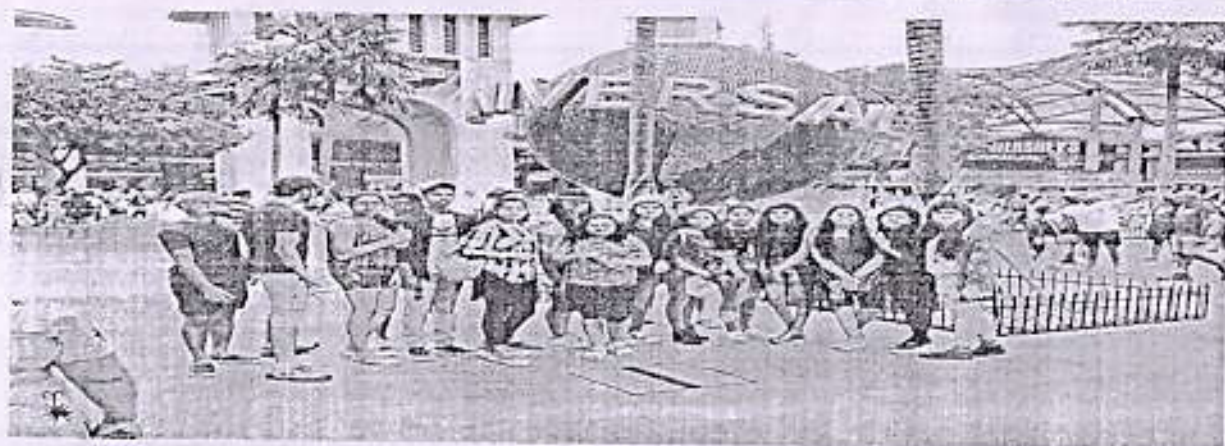
Such industrial visits really enhance value-added learning for the students. It is an important module of the programme, and more are planned to other countries to expose the students to other industries.

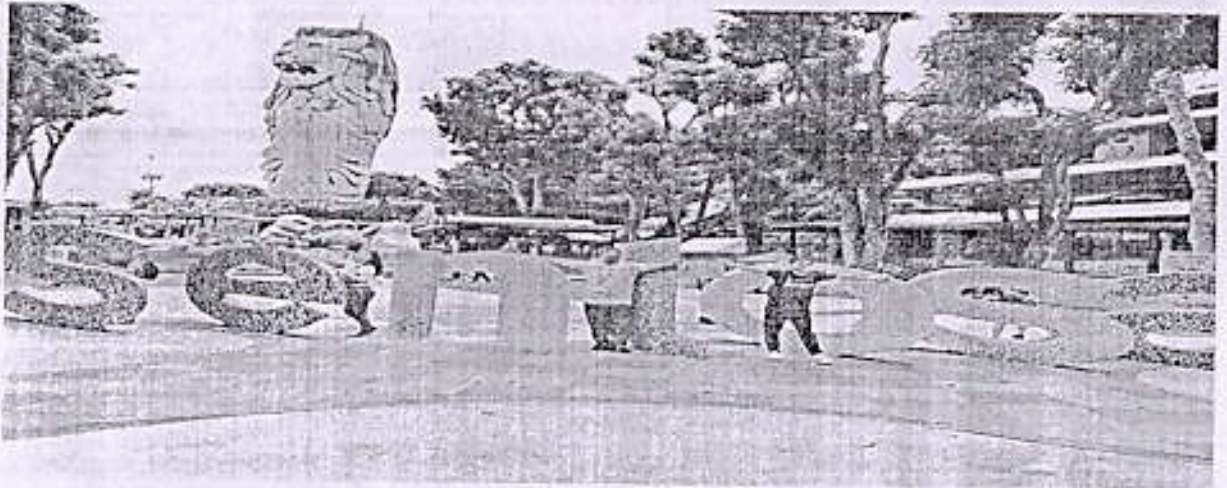
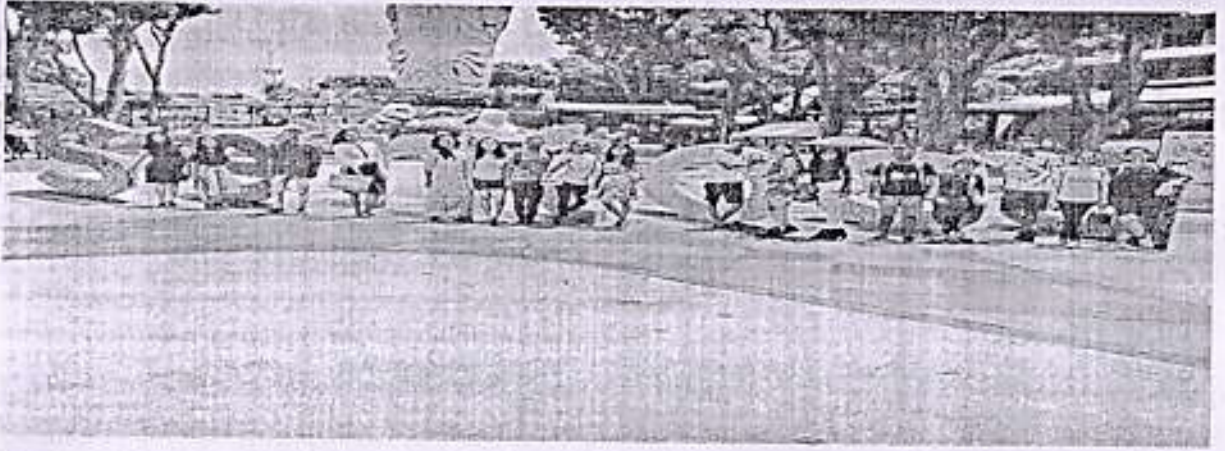

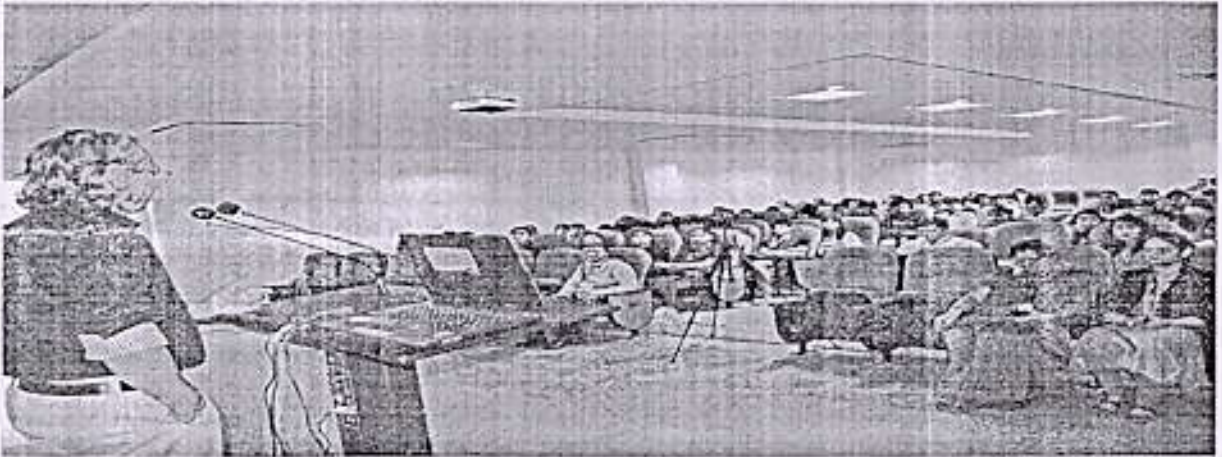
The veteran actor said that Acting on stage teaches you how to be comfortable speaking in front of large audiences and some of your theatre classes will give you additional experience talking to groups. Furthermore, your work on crews has taught you that clear, precise, and well-organized oral communications are best. He also said that being involved in theatre productions and classes' demands commitment and motivation. These are qualities that college theatre faculty members and, in some measure, you and your fellow students, probably already possess.

Mr. Naik concluded his lecture by stating that theatre training teaches you confidence in yourself. Your accomplishments in theatre show you that you can handle a variety of jobs, pressures, difficulties and responsibilities. You develop a "Yes, I can!" attitude. 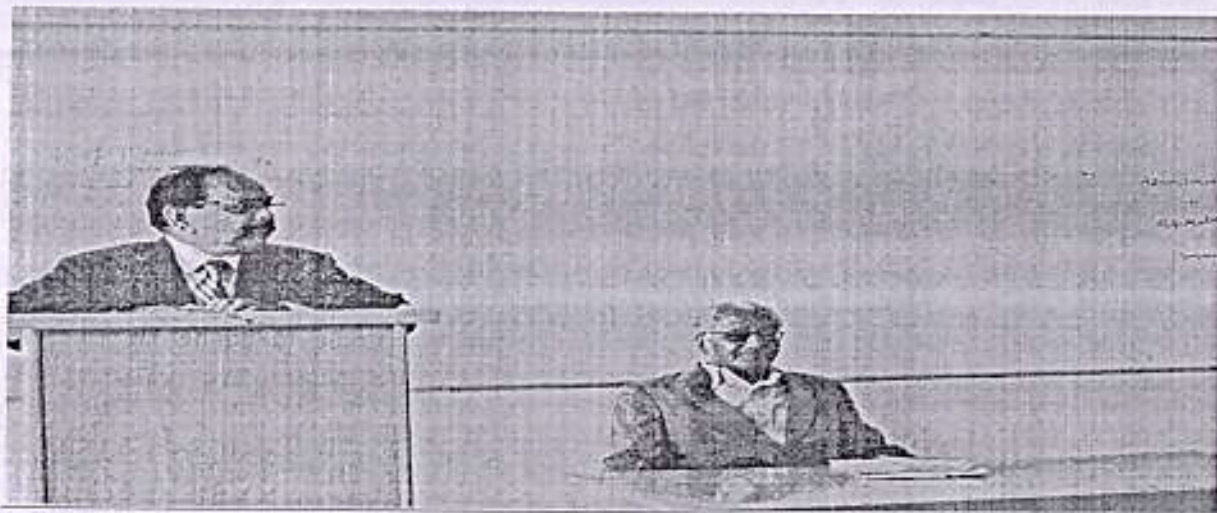
Prof. Kanti Kumar Kochar, Retired Dean of Law, MDS University, Ajmer delivered a Guest Lecture on "Law on equal rights of Hindu daughters over ancestral property under Hindu succession act 1956" at RNB Global University, Bikaner. During the discussion Prof. Kochar discussed many concepts of Hindu Succession Act with special ref. to equal rights of Hindu daughters over ancestral property. She also emphasized on judgment of Supreme Court of India in the case of Prakash & ors. Vs. Phulavati & ors. (2016)2 SCC 36 in which Apex Court of our country held that the rights under the amendment are applicable to living daughters of living coparceners as on 9-9-2005 irrespective of when such daughters are born.

Disposition or alienation including partitions which may have taken place before 20-12-2004 as per law applicable prior to the said date will remain unaffected. This gave a sound footing to this philosophy which can be considered to be golden move in the direction of gender justice in so far as the Indian scenario is concerned.

The speech of Prof. Kochar was followed by an interactive session with students as well as faculty members. Students were overwhelmed to gain the knowledge of law. The insightful session was concluded with vote of thanks to the speaker. Such a informative sessions, packed with statistical figures, acts as an inspiration for the budding law professionals to work towards such dimensions.

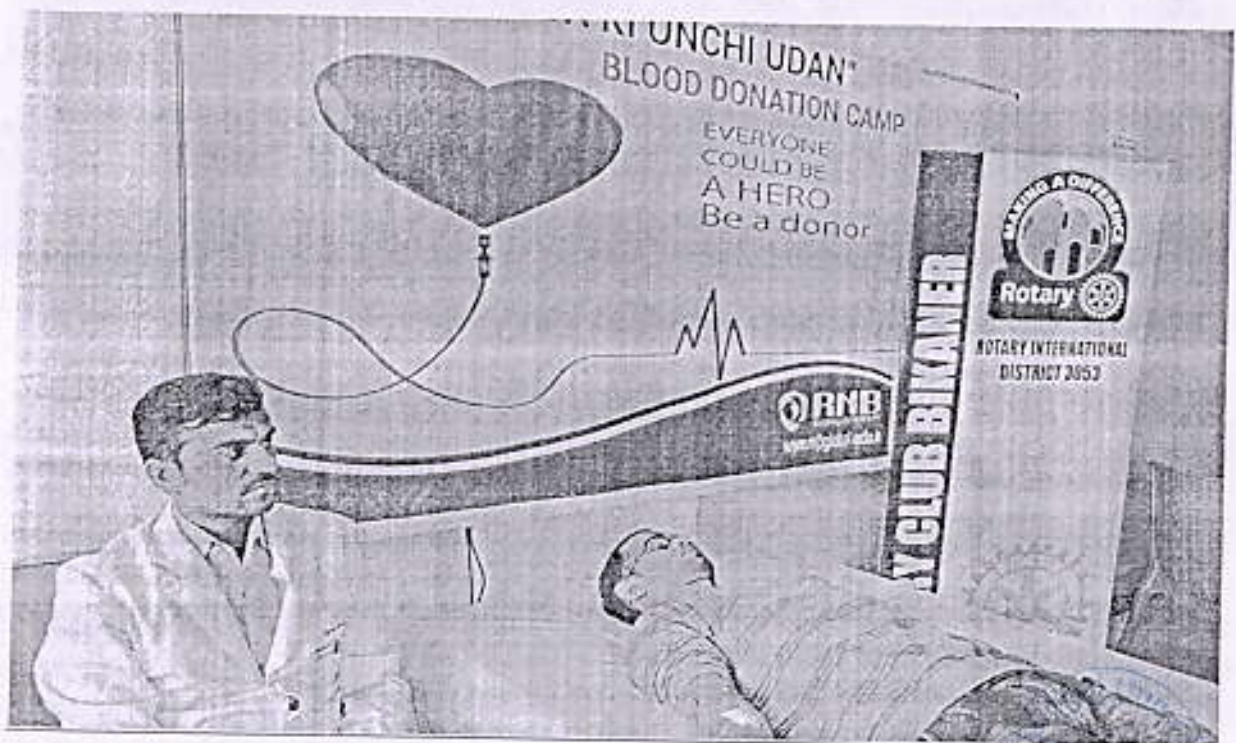

After the presentation was over the speaker asked for questions.

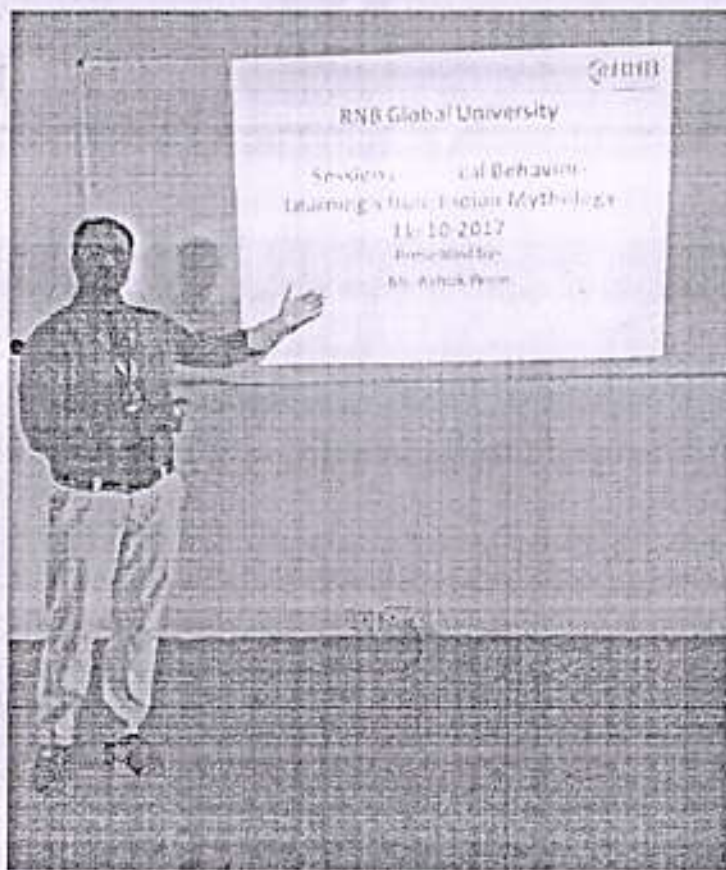
