Some Exciting games were also arranged for the students like one Minute Game show, Musical Chairs, Balloon Blowing etc were enjoyed by all the students.

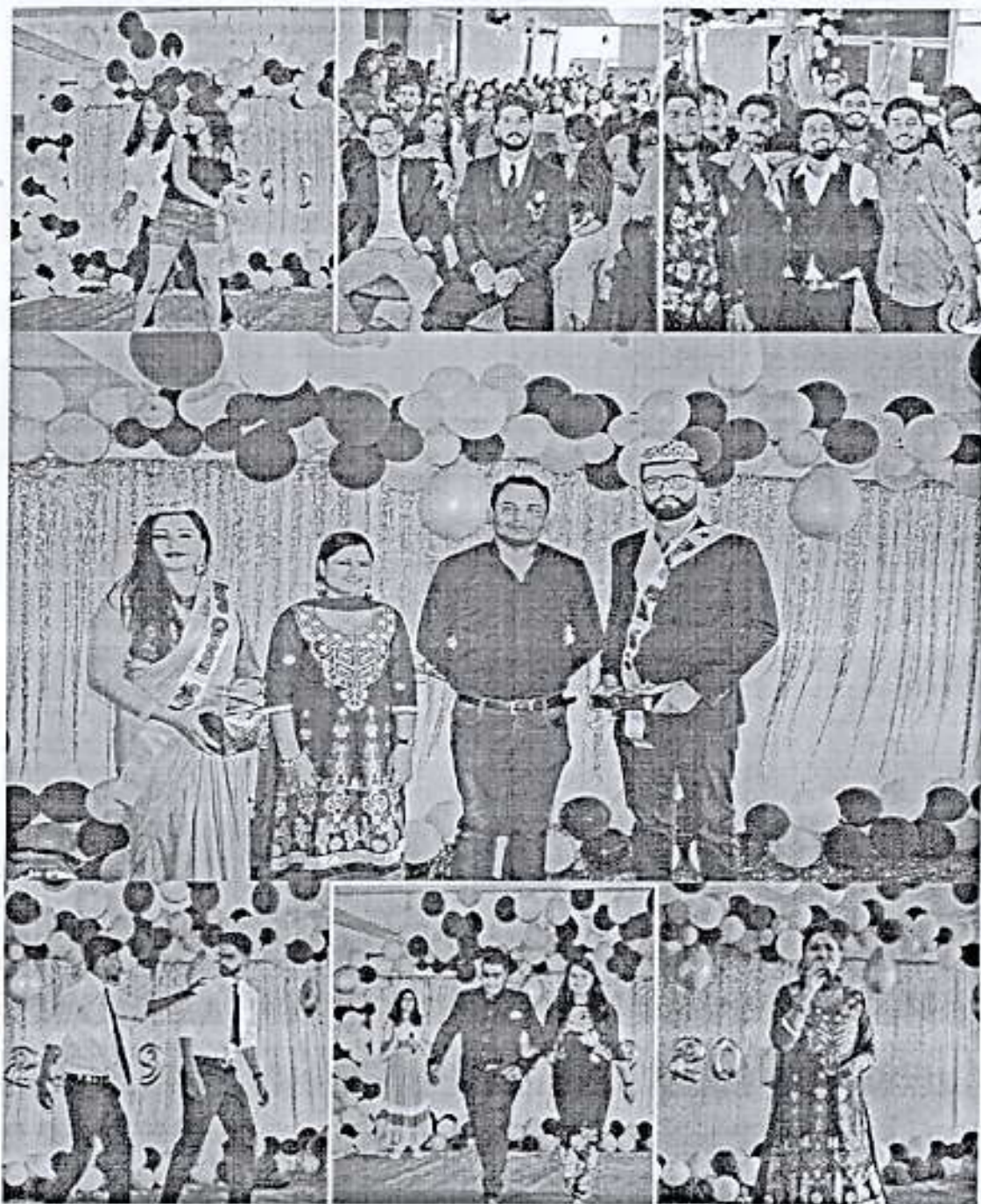

RNBian's had a chance to interact with National School of Drama alumnus, celebrated movie and theatre actor, Mr. Ashok Banthia when he visited the campus.

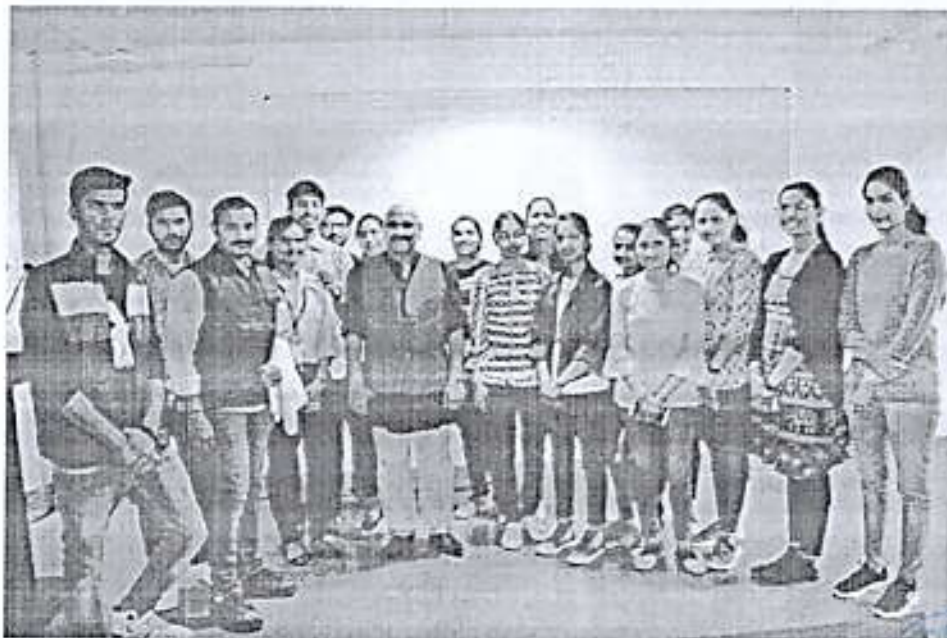

During All 5 Days the BTF 4 celebrity visited our University. Detail are following

1. **Ms. Sanjana Kapoor** : Co-founder & Director. Sanjna spearheads the Arts at Play for Schools programme, loves the sheer energy and excitement of the arts and is brilliant at curating this for eager audiences. She instigated the creation of the India Theatre Forum (ITF) because she was feeling lonely, and is currently part of the core team as well as a core team member and facilitator for SMART - Strategic Management in the Art of Theatre. Many of you will remember her for building Prithvi Theatre into a warm, inviting cultural hub, some of you will remember her for her earnest Amul India Show questioning, and some of you apparently loved her in Hero Hiralal - a confession which never fails to embarrass her. She believes in multi-tasking, and will one day possibly achieve being in multiple places at once - so that she can always be with theatre and always be with her son at one and the same time. When you don't find her messing about with the arts, you'll probably find her in the jungles of Africa or scuba-diving in some beautiful ocean somewhere, talking to the manta-rays.

2. **Ashok Banthia** - Famous by the name Ashok Banthia is a Hindi film actor as well as director. Ashok was born in Udaipur in a traditional business family. In the year 1932, after earning a diploma in theatre and dramatics from Punjab University, Chandigarh, Ashok went to the National School of Drama in New Delhi followed by a course in the direction at the National Institute of Dramatic Arts (NIDA), in Sydney.

3. **Michel Lestrehan** - Demonstration of Kathakali He is Experiences with contemporary choreographers in Paris from 1977 (Carolyn Carlson, Karine Saporta, Yano Hideyuki) Michel Lestréhan entered into the Indian dance in 1984 with Kathak in Ahmedabad with Kumudini Lakhia and Arjun Mishra. After one year, he went to Kerala where he was fascinated by the Kathakali dance-theater. He started to study in Kerala Kalamandalam with great master Vazhenkada Vijayan. He returned to Kerala in 1987 for six years to continue the practice of Kathakali in Kalamandalam, and then with Sadanam Krishnankutty. All these years were under the support of Indo-French Cultural Exchange scholarships. Beside Kathakali, Michel practiced also Kalaripayatt martial art in P.K.B. Kalari Sangham with Balan Gurukkal. In India, Michel was participating in Kalamandalam's troupe for programs, and performed several major roles of Kathakali in India and Europe. He organizes also regular tours with great Kathakali artists. His research is based on his early experiences with Western contemporary dance and the inspiration from Indian techniques. He worked on several choreographic pieces, mainly with Indian dancers and musicians.

4. **Bishoy Aniyani** - Bamboo & Saxophone Performance - Famous Music composer, who had also worked at Mathalam: A Ethnic Music Band amazed the audience with his classical flute and saxophone performance.

6. Integrate an understanding of diversity, multiculturalism, and identity in the process, practice and study of theatre.



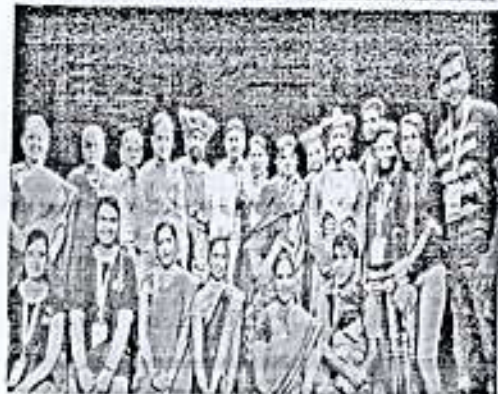

In continuation of human endeavour by RNB Global University, a free dental check-ups and awareness camp was organized at University campus. Dr. Vaibhav Sachdev and Dr. Rachna Sachdev along with Para-medical staff carried out a comprehensive dental check-up for the students and staff members of the University.

The camp was initiated with dental awareness talk, educating students about common dental ailments, especially stressing on tooth decay and gum diseases and measures to prevent from them. ## “RIGHTS OF WOMEN”

19 January, 2019

RNB Global University has organised a One day Training programme “RIGHTS OF WOMEN” in collaboration with *National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi*, at its campus at RNB Global City, Near Khara, Bikaner-Sri Ganganagar Highway, Bikaner on 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. This Training programme provided a platform to learn Rights of Women for Research Scholars, Faculty members and women in general from experts on the intricacies and solutions of various difficulties faced by women. The details of the programme are as follows:

1. There were four Sessions from 10 am to 5.30 pm. The participants registered were 112.
2. Details of the Training programme has been as follows:

- (a) Mr. Shreshth Bhatnagar, the Convener, of the programme introduced the Resource Persons and invited all the participants to take together by standing with right arm raised, ‘The Human Rights Pledge’. It gave necessary sanctity to the programme.
- (b) The First Session, started at exact 10.00 am, concentrated on ‘Origin & Development of Human Rights Movement’.

The Resource Person was Prof. M. Afzal Wani, Dean Department of Law, GGSIP University, Delhi & Former Member Indian Law Commission, Government of India, New Delhi.

His speech on the topic has been scholarly, elaborate, well prepared, easy to understand and brought forward the development of Human Rights even before Magna Carta, generally referred in European Countries as the beginning of the idea of Human Rights.

- (c) A High Tea after Session one was a need of the hour. The participants enjoyed it, due to cold weather and a long but educative lecture.
- (d) The Second Session was on ‘Working of Female foeticide and Pre-conception and Prenatal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 2003’.

The Resource Person was Prof. K.B. Asthana, Principal, CPJ-CHS & School of Law, GGS-IP University, Delhi.

He expressed the causes of the enactment particularly the craving of Hindus for a son and practice of female foeticide. The desire of a male child and malpractices of medical professions was elaborately discussed along with the technical details of the Act of 2003. As he was requested to deliver only two days back only due to sudden emergency of Prof. KPS Mehwar, National Law University, Delhi; Formerly, Head & Dean, Department of Law, M.D. University Rohtak who was to attend the Training Programme, the organizers are highly thankful for such a beautiful power point presentation on the topic.

- (e) The Lunch after the Second Session was quite good. All Resource Persons and participants enjoyed it and especially the sweets served in the lunch.
- (f) The Third Session was on ‘Violence against Women & Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005’. Prof. S.S. Lal, Former Head & Dean, Department of Law, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur was the Resource Person.

The Concept of Violence and Violence on women and jurisprudential aspects of the Act was explained to the participant with the help of LED presentations. He has also dealt



with Law, morality and Ethics. The impact of legislation at different places and the status of women after divorce was discussed with participants.

- (g) Tea after Third Session was a blessing to already mentally and physically exhausted participants. It was taken as a sweet gesture at good time by all.
- (h) Lastly the Fourth Session was on **"Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace and Judicial Activism in India"**.

The Resource Person was **Prof. U.C. Sankhla**, Former Vice Chancellor, Dr B R Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur and Head and Dean, Department of Law, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

The Vishakha case, was discussed along with conditions of women in prevailing patriarchal society at least in northern India. The causes of enactment of the Legislature along with its effectiveness were explained by him. He also discussed the "Me Too" campaigns and its impact on the contemporary society.

3. At about 5.15 pm, Prof. G.S. Karkara, Dean Law, RNBGU, thanked all the Resource Persons, Participants, law students and other faculty members of RNBGU.
4. National Anthem at the end of the Programme was sung with great enthusiasm.
5. An amount of Rs. 50,000 has sanctioned by the NHRC and a minimum Rs. 10,000/- was to be spent by the RNB Global University to organize the Training programme.
6. Photostat copies of articles distributed to the participants (about 52 pages in each 120 kits = 6000 pages approximately), Videography, Sound systems, and Photography has been possible out of present resources of the RNBGU itself and so no separate expenses have been shown on these accounts. The expenses if incurred from outside service providers would not be less than 20,000/- on these items, put together.
7. As all the four Resource Persons were from out of Bikaner, minor variations had occurred in various heads of expenses of resource persons than what was proposed, but due to able professional financial acumen of the persons dealing with expenditures on the Training Programme, an amount of Rs. 62,228 has actually been spent by the School of Law, RNBGU in organising the Training Programme. A detailed verified expenditure account alongwith original vouchers 26 in number (Marked as Ann. 1 to Ann. 26) are being sent.

The Training Programme has been useful for the participants especially the women participants. The participants are explained legal issues involved problems of women in contemporary society and possible legal solutions by the expert Resource Persons.

Rs. 25,000 (Twenty five thousands) has already been received from the NHRC out of its total sanctioned amount of Rs. 50,000. Looking into the expenses incurred by the RNB Global University out of its own resources, the remaining part of the sanctioned amount is to be reimbursed by the NHRC.

- **Working of Female feticide and Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 2003**'. The Resource Person was Prof. K.B. Asthana, Principal, CPJ-CHS & School of Law, GGS-IP University, Delhi.
- **Violence against Women & Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005**'. Prof. S.S. Lal, Former Head & Dean, Department of Law, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur was the Resource Person.
- **"Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace and Judicial Activism in India"**.  
The Resource Person was Prof. U.C. Sankhla, Former Vice Chancellor, Dr B R Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur and Head and Dean, Department of Law, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

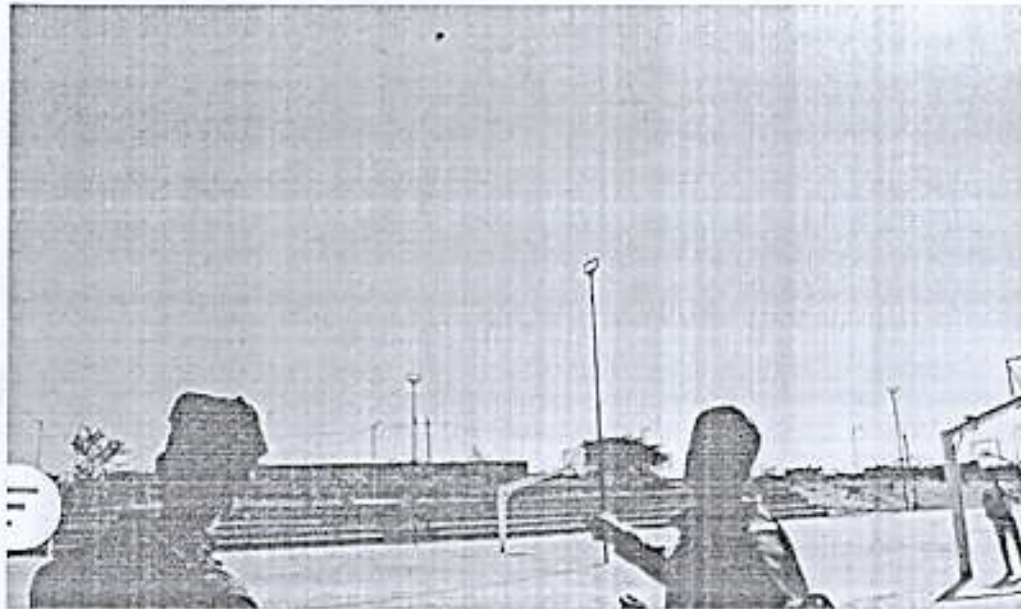
