
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## **MESSAGE FROM HON'BLE CHAIRPERSON**


## **World Class Infrastructure**



## Lecture on Environment Day

Dr. Arundeeep Ahluwalia is an Environmental and Geosciences activist. He is a Professor of Eminence, Environmental Sciences, Shoolini University, Solan. Prof. Ahluwalia delivered a guest lecture entitled: Excitements of Mother Earth & its environmental issues & disasters, on 20 March, 2017 at RNB Global University. He explained the definition of 'geopark' and the possibilities of creating geoparks in India. He also said that Rajasthan has great possibilities of creating geoparks due to its rich culture and glorious history. He also explained the economic impacts of creating geoparks and participation of youth in this step. He then switched to the biggest problem of the global world, i.e. pollution. He talked about pollution briefly. He enumerated about the effects of pollution on health with some examples. He particularly mentioned the case of Delhi to explain the effects of pollution in the Capital and added that it is increasing at an alarming rate in other major cities of India as well! He showed some statistics of pollution in India and the steps taken by the government as wells as media in making people aware about it. He also shared some posters made against pollution and awareness toward it.

In general words, Goods and Services Tax (GST) are a proposed system of indirect taxation in India merging most of the existing taxes into a single system of taxation. It was introduced by The Constitution (One Hundred and First Amendment) Act 2016. By amalgamating a large number of Central and State taxes into a single tax, it would mitigate cascading or double taxation in a major way and pave the way for a common national market. From the consumer point of view, the biggest advantage would be in terms of a reduction in the overall tax burden on goods, which is currently estimated to be around 25%-30%.

The main point of discussion was the recent judgment of Supreme Court of India on triple Talaq. Mr. Bari expressed the opinion that this judgment is not against any institution, neither organisation nor it is against the religion of Islam. Rather, the true meaning and spirit of the Quran has been outlined on the anvil of individualism, the rule of law and human rights enunciated in the constitution. It is a judgment in favour of justice based on women's rights as human rights that have been denied to Muslim women for centuries despite Quranic provisions relating to gender and spousal equality in wedlock and beyond. The Quran does not sanction triple talaq in one go. He further elaborated that according to Islamic scripture, the word talaq is spoken thrice over a period of three months

The major points on which the forum (students of BBA, B.Com, MBA) stressed was "how revenue can be generated by the govt. without increasing the taxes."

Some of the issues of concern with reference to revenue generation as discussed by forum were: Inflation control to be the top priority; Personal tax exemption limit to be increased to boost demand; The fiscal deficits should be less than 3% of our GDP; Approximate 10, 00,000 lakhs projects are still non-operating, should be made operational; GST should be passed in parliament; There should be more focus on - Urbanisation, Information sector regarding agriculture, Developed infrastructure, Introducing new agriculture schemes to boost agriculture related activities and milking poultry projects and Irrigation facility should be boosted.




## Quiz, Debate & Extempore Competition



**Bikaner City**

Bikaner is a city in the northwest of the state of Rajasthan, India. It is located 130 kilometers (205 mi) northwest of the state capital, Jaipur. Bikaner city is the administrative headquarters of Bikaner District and Bikaner Division.

Formerly the capital of the princely state of Bikaner, the city was founded by Rao Bika in 1486 and then its small region it has developed into the fourth largest city in Rajasthan. The Gangetic Canal, completed in 1928, and the Indira Gandhi Canal, completed in 1987, facilitated its development.

The city celebrates its foundation day on Ashvini Tritiya by flying kites and eating special Rajasthan food that includes Bikaneri Ka Kheerda and Thali Paan (Fenestrated Water) among other foods. The celebration lasts for two days, known as Chhoti Asha Tiji and Bada Asha Tiji. People can be seen flying kites during these two days right from the early morning at 5-6am till late noon.

The city is most famous for its sensory snack Bikaneri which is sold all over the world. It is also known for a large variety of curries that are offered and the spicy papad which is another speciality. The Sannas and the Kachori which you get at every work and corner are highly recommended by the locals.

**Triple Talaq Verdict by Supreme Court**

The Supreme Court's decision to declare the practice of triple talaq as unconstitutional is a milestone in the Muslim women's rights movement in India. Triple talaq — or the practice whereby a Muslim husband pronounced talaq (divorce) three times in one sitting — has been outlawed. One variation is pronouncing talaq three times in one sitting, either verbally or through written letters such as phone call, text, WhatsApp, Skype, SMS and the like. The other is pronouncing a talaq each over four months.

At the time of writing this article, it is unclear if both the variations of triple talaq were struck down by the Supreme Court. However, it seems the practice of triple talaq was declared unconstitutional by a 3:2 majority of the court. It was the instant triple talaq which was in the center of controversy due to its arbitrary use by Muslim husbands. The decision is a milestone in the life of the poorer sections of Muslim women who on the worst off and don't have the resources to sue for it.

**World Environment Day Highlights Deadly Cost of Plastic**



On June 5th, World Environment Day will be hosted in India under the banner of "Beat Plastic Pollution," aiming to raise awareness and civic engagement alongside creating a global movement to reduce the amount of plastic in the environment. Plastic bags and bottles comprise a major part of the rubbish that clogs this delicate mountain ecosystem when scores of Hindu devotees flock to the sacredness of the cave in Kashmir to worship a representation of the god Shiva.

World Environment Day addresses four main campaigns. First, it seeks to decrease the amount of single-use plastic items. Second, it will try to improve plastic waste management, since plastic takes hundreds of years to degrade, poisoning the soil and even getting into the food we eat. Third, it aims to phase out microplastics because recent studies show that 99 percent of bottled water and 83 percent of tap water contain plastic particles which affect blood, stomach and lung. Finally, this global platform intends to coordinate further research in order to create alternatives to plastic.

As synthetic polymers can be transformed into cheap, lightweight and durable products, demand for plastic is growing worldwide, rising from 5 million tons in the 1950s to over 300 million tons in 2017. The UN has estimated that more than 5 trillion plastic bags are consumed annually while 17 million barrels of oil are used to produce plastic. At the same time, 50 percent of this plastic is for single-time use, making the share of plastic in human-generated waste 39 percent.

Fortunately, an increasing number of individuals avoid consuming single-use plastic items and volunteer to clean the environment. However, individual action alone is not enough to solve this global problem. As the source of the problem lies in "manufacturing, distribution, consumption and trade systems for plastic," the whole "global economy needs to change". Subsequently, active involvement of governments who will implement competent legislation regarding production and management of plastic items is needed.



# BIKANER CITY



Bikaner is a city in Rajasthan, India's northwest province. It is situated northwest of the state capital, Jaipur, 330 kilometres (205 mi). Bikaner City is the Bikaner District and Bikaner Division's administrative headquarters. Formerly the capital of Bikaner's princely state, the city was founded in 1486 by Rao Bika and has developed into Rajasthan's fourth largest city from its small origins. The 1928 Ganges Canal and the 1987 Indira Gandhi Canal facilitated its development. The city celebrates its founding day on Akshaya Tritiya by flying kites and eating special Rajasthani food which includes BajreKa Khichda and Imlika Paani. The celebration, called Chhoti AkhaTeej and Badi Akha Teej, lasts two days. The city is best known for its savoury Bhujia snack, which is sold throughout the world. It is also known for a wide range of namkeens and the spicy papad that is another specialty. that manufacture glass, pottery, felts, chemicals, shoes, and cigarettes. The city's colleges (including a medical school and a teachers' training institute) are affiliated with the University of Rajasthan in Jaipur.
