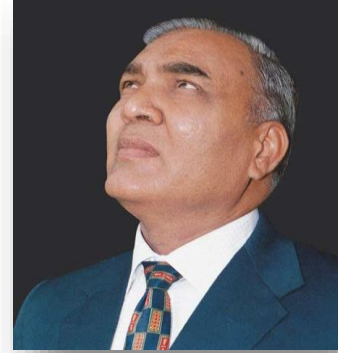

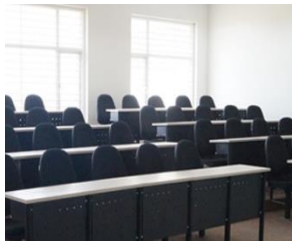


## **World Class Infrastructure**

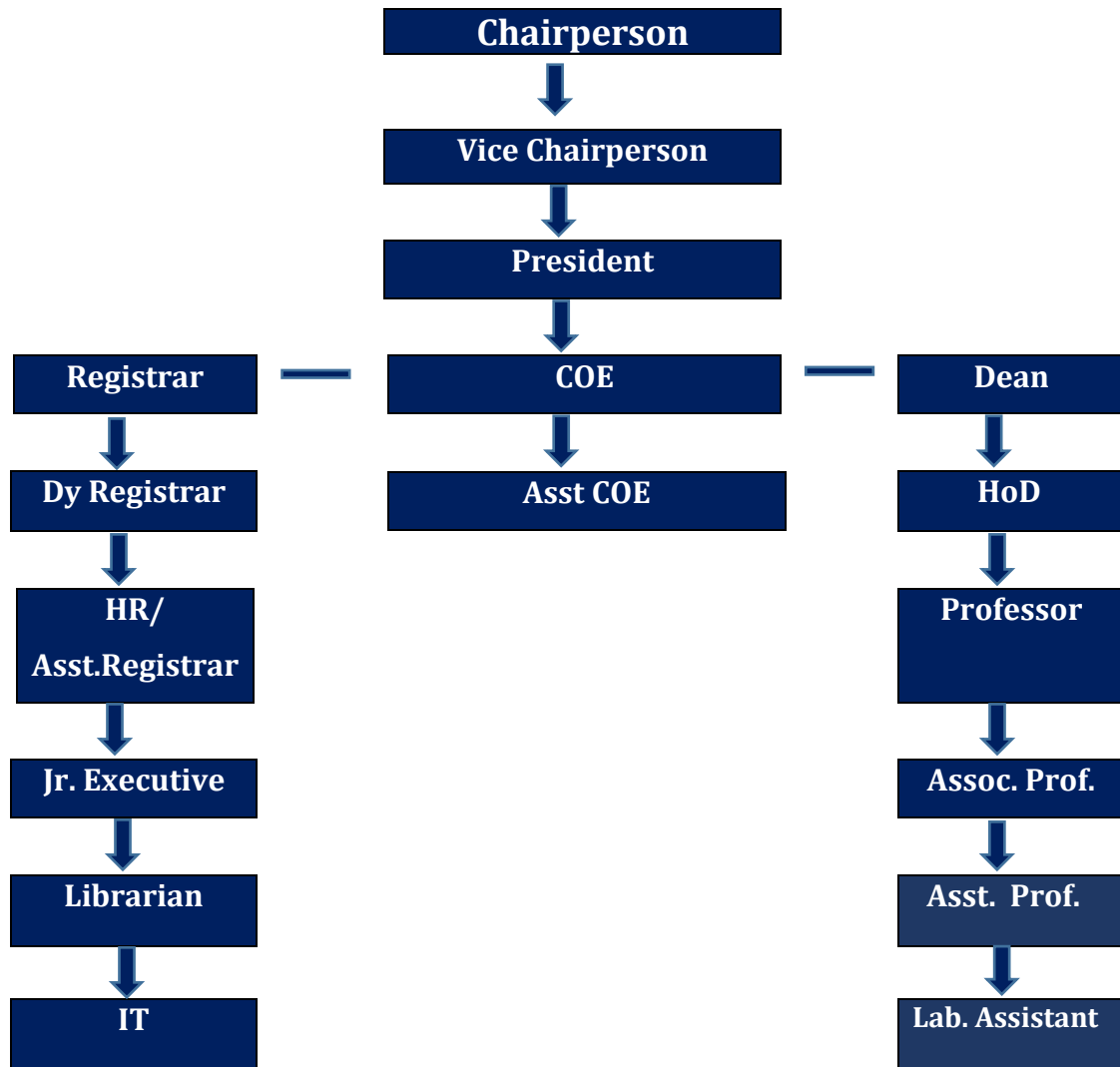

The main point of discussion was the recent judgment of Supreme Court of India on triple Talaq. Mr. Bari discussed that how the stand of the Apex Court in making the practice of Triple Talaq unconstitutional can be a guiding star in true realization of equality. Mr. Bari expressed the opinion that this judgment is not against any institution, neither organization nor it is against the religion of Islam. Rather, the true meaning and spirit of the Quran has been outlined on the anvil of individualism, the rule of law and human rights enunciated in the constitution. It is a judgment in favour of justice based on women's rights as human rights that have been denied to Muslim women for centuries despite Quranic provisions relating to gender and spousal equality in wedlock and beyond. The Quran does not sanction triple talaq in one go. He further elaborated that according to Islamic scripture, the word talaq is spoken thrice over a period of three months. Students were very curious to learn the impact of the decision of the apex court on society.

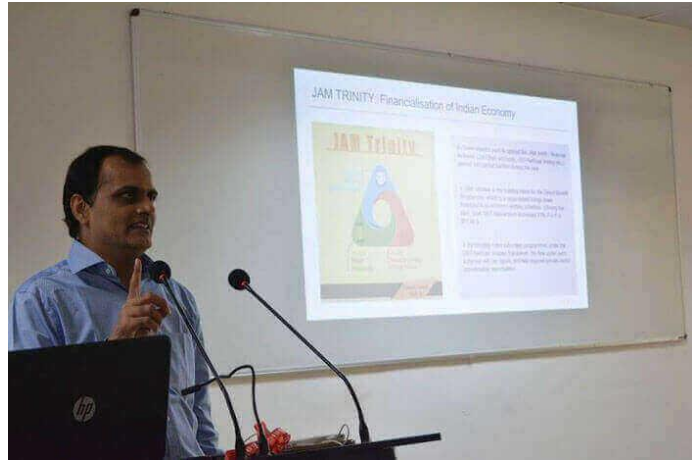

Such industrial exposure really sensitizes the students to the practical challenges that organizations face in the business world. It was a wonderful and interactive visit, where the students understood the production processes, products and operation of one of the best examples of co-operative achievement in the developing economy.

The entire event was divided into two days in which Day 1 was scheduled for Preliminary Rounds followed by the Inauguration ceremony. Final rounds including semifinals and finals were held on 2<sup>nd</sup> day.

Seedling School of Law and Governance, Jaipur National University, Jaipur Won the First Prize (Rs. 21,000 + Trophy + Certificate) and the team of Biyani Law College (Boys), Jaipur was the runner up (Rs. 11,000 + Trophy + Certificate) in the competition. Mr. Yashpal Kumar, BBA, LLB 1<sup>st</sup> Semester student of RNB Global University won the best researcher award (Rs. 2100 + Trophy + Certificate). BJS Rampuria Jain Law College won the Best memorial award (Rs. 3100).



## Industrial Visit to Neyveli Lignite Corporation, Barsinghsar, 18 Nov 2017

RNBGU organized an Industrial visit to Neyveli Lignite Corporation, Barsinghsar, Bikaner for Science and Engineering students in which students learned about working at the entire 250 x 2 Mega Watt power generation plant. In NLC, the engineers gave a detailed explanation about the site and the on-going process in the plant. The installed plant capacity is 2,740 MW. The plant receives the coal from Mines



1 and Mines 2 in Neyveli. The coal used is lignite which has more amount of ash content. The coal is transported through belt conveyor before getting it to the boilers. Students had a look at the preheating process and the types of fans used for the cooling process. The plant engineers also explained about ash handling and ash filtration processes. The exhaust gases and the fly ash are passed through a chimney constructed at a standard height of about 275 m. The super-heated steam ( $540^{\circ}\text{C}$ ) is sent to the turbine of 3 types: high pressure turbine, medium pressure turbine and low-pressure turbine. Turbo alternator is present on the same shaft where turbine is present. Turbo alternator runs at a rated speed of 3000 rpm. The overall process is monitored and controlled by PLC programs. The Indigenous Hoist Winch Gear box and brake frames are used in the machines for the first time in the history of NLC. The imported critical components include the bucket wheel gear box, main slew gear box and discharge boom slew gearbox, main slew and discharge slew bearing. The students were given an overview starting from the lignite mining to pulverization and its screening. They got an idea of working of boilers for the generation of steam and its maintenance by physical and chemical means and finally the use of superheated steam which drives an electric generator.





# Guest Lecture on “Career Scope in Armed Forces”

22 Nov 2017

A Guest lecture on “**Career Scope in Armed Forces**” for Science and Engineering students was organized on 22 November 2017 in which Mr. Abhinav Singh, 2nd in Command, Border Security Force, Srigananar, shared his vast experience with the students. This lecture provided a rare opportunity for the students to gain an insight into the work and life of officers of the Indian military.



Mr. Singh started the session with the statement that is “Being in the armed forces is not just a job; it is a way of life”. He also said that the Students of today are well-informed and the driving force of tomorrow so instead of blaming the system, you all should come together and mould the nation for a better tomorrow. The main idea behind this session was to give awareness to the youth that how they can have a complete career track in various fields.

Dr. Daya Shankar Kulshreshtha, Former Professor of Theoretical Physics, Department of Physics and Astrophysics, University of Delhi delivered an interactive Guest lecture on **"Exotic Stars, Black Holes, Wormholes and Time Travel"** at University Campus.



Starting from the Newtonian laws, he creatively developed the concept of Quantum Field Theory, Special Theory of Relativity, General Theory of Relativity and Finally Explained the concept of Planck's time. Students of Science and Engineering were highly enthusiastic to know about the development of Black holes and neutron stars from Stellar Nebula. The concept of time travel through the wormhole fascinated the students as well as faculty members. Dr. Kulshreshtha also discussed about the Quarks, Leptons, Riemanian Geometry and Minkowski Space.

He also discussed that how astronomers make deductions about the important physical processes operating in the Universe when they are forced to play the role of passive observer rather than active experimentalist. He suggested the students to develop the skills by looking at a large range of astrophysical phenomena on scales from exoplanets to quasars. The lecture provided an immersion in topics in contemporary astrophysics but the examinable content of the area - and the supervision problem sets.

# Seminar on Art of Mind Control

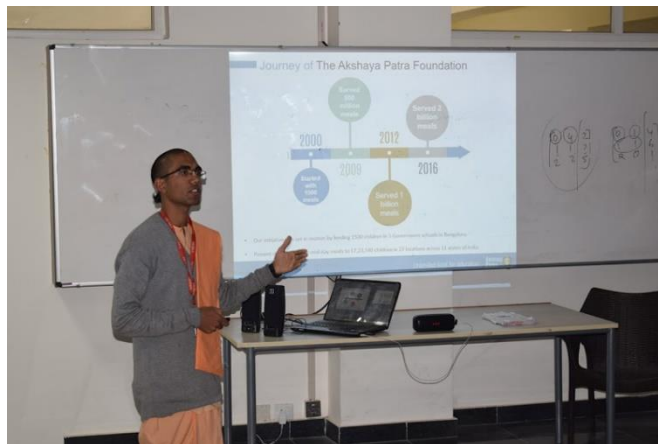
## 22 Jan 2018

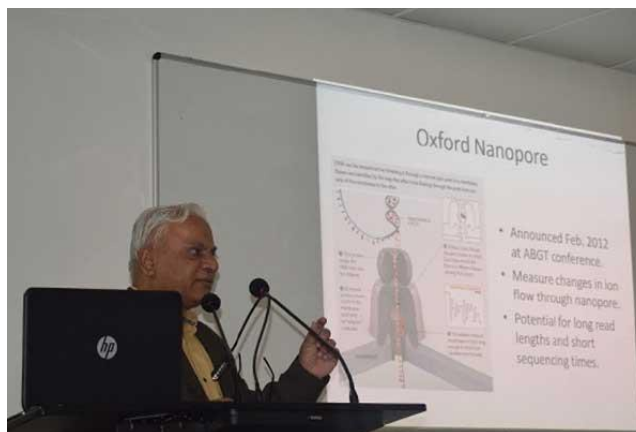

# Seminar on Role and Appointment of Auditor in a Company, 23 Feb 2018

Mr. N.K. Goyal, leading CA and having vast experience in the field of Audit, delivered a Seminar on “Role and Appointment of Auditor in Company”. The main point of discussion was the Role and Appointment of Auditors under the Companies Act, 2013. After enlightening students about the procedure to be followed for appointing Auditors Mr. Goyal has pointed the important issues like appointment of auditor as per the companies act. out that



every Company shall appoint an Individual or firm as an Auditor at the First Annual General Meeting who shall hold office from the conclusion of this meeting until the conclusion of sixth Annual general Meeting, provided that Company shall place the matter relating to such appointment of ratification by members at every Annual General Meeting. Further provided that before such appointment Company should obtain the written consent from the Auditor and certificate which shall indicate the criteria as mentioned in Section.141. Company shall file the said appointment with the Registrar of Companies.

How an Individual or audit firm who has completed their term shall not be eligible for appointment as auditor in the same Company for five years from the completion of such term; no audit firm having a common partner/Partners to the other audit firm, whose tenure has expired in a company immediately preceding the financial year, shall be appointed as auditor of the same company for a period of five years—these were the points upon which Mr. Goyal emphasized.



## District Court Visit by Students of Law

Students of School of Law, RNB Global University visited the District Court of Bikaner. The purpose of the visit was to understand the working of a court, the nature of duties of the judicial officers. Prof. Kanti Kumar Kochar, Retired Dean of Law, MDS University, Ajmer delivered a Guest Lecture on “Law on equal rights of Hindu daughters over ancestral property under Hindu succession act 1956” at RNB Global University, Bikaner. During the discussion Prof. Kochar discussed many concepts of Hindu Succession Act with special ref. to equal rights of Hindu daughters over ancestral property. She also emphasized on judgment of Supreme Court of India in the case of Prakash & ors. Vs. Phulavati & ors. (2016)2 SCC 36 in which Apex Court of our country held that the rights under the amendment are applicable to living daughters of living coparceners as on 9-9-2005 irrespective of when such daughters are born. Disposition or alienation including partitions which may have taken place before 20-12-2004 as per law applicable prior to the said date will remain unaffected. This gave a sound footing to this philosophy which can be considered to be golden move in the direction of gender justice in so far as the Indian scenario is concerned.



The speech of Prof. Kochar was followed by an interactive session with students as well as faculty members. Students were overwhelmed to gain the knowledge of law. The insightful session was concluded with vote of thanks to the speaker. Such a informative sessions, packed with statistical figures, acts as an inspiration for the budding law professionals to work towards such dimensions.

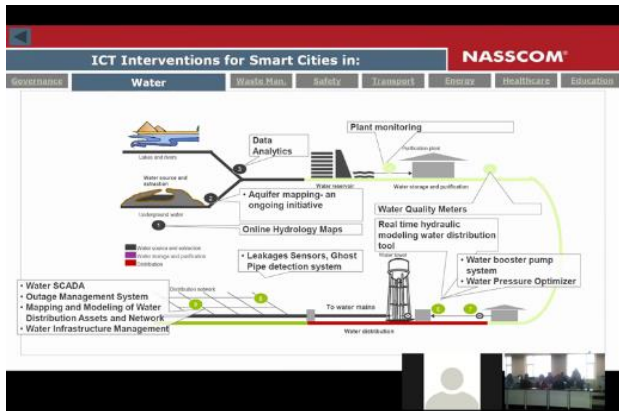


# Webinar on Role of IS in Development Projects of Smart City, 08 Feb 2018

He discussed and deliberated on Industrial relations in which he briefed about the evolution of this concept during industrial era and traced its relevance to the present-day business context. Through real case incidents he highlighted the changing paradigms of industrial relations as employee relations in today's modern business world, role of labor laws and its impact on the management of the employees especially the more informed and aware ones, the ethical dilemmas the HR managers face while making a choice between welfare of employee on humane grounds and/or on the basis of following organizational policies and challenges of managing the employee relations which is based on "trust" of both the management and employees. He elicited students' response to practical real-life situations where in they had to make a decision; that could be right either ethically or legally! Thus, the students understood the various facets of the employee-employer relations and its significance in an organization.

The University infrastructure offers superior and high-end technology and is committed to make use of new age technology to create a better learning experience for the students.



## Guest Lecture on “Ultraviolet Spectroscopy: Concept, Theory and Applications”, 28 Mar 2018

Dr Ramesh Kumar, Department of Chemistry, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and having Post-Doctoral Research Experience from Taiwan delivered an invited Guest Lecture to Science Students on the topic entitled “Ultraviolet Spectroscopy: Concept, Theory and Applications” in which he discussed three key spectroscopic methods used by chemists and biochemists to analyse the molecular and electronic structure of atoms and molecules.



These are UV/Visible, Infra-red (IR) and Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) spectroscopies. He further explained various concepts like determination of structure of an organic compound. He said that in the past, such techniques were laboriously time consuming and sometimes unreliable too. Modern technology has sorted out this difficulty with the advent of spectroscopic methods for determination of structure.

During the lecture Dr. Kumar introduced the electromagnetic spectrum and the origin of transitions giving rise to ultraviolet and visible (UV/Vis) spectra. He further said that electronic transitions are caused by absorption of radiation in the UV/Vis region of the electromagnetic spectrum. The reason for the wavelength and intensity of bands were also described and the colour origin of certain compounds were major point of discussion.

Such an interactive session for Final Year Students really helps the candidates to groom in professional life along with practical knowledge from the academic and industry expert.





## Webinar on “Right to Privacy” – Judgement of Honorable SC on Aadhaar Card, 28 Mar 2018

Mr. Pritam Ghosh, Senior Professor, Karnataka State Law University, delivered a webinar on Right to Privacy. The point of discussion was judgment of Supreme Court on Aadhaar card. Covering this topic is carrying contextual relevancy owing to its subtle relation with the various subjects namely Constitutional Law, Family Law and Administrative Law.



Mr. Ghosh specifically pointed out that the verdict is being seen as a major setback for the government, which had earlier argued in the apex court that the Constitution does not guarantee individual privacy as an inalienable Fundamental Right. "The Right to Privacy is protected as an intrinsic part of the Right to Life and Personal Liberty under Article 21 and as a part of the freedoms guaranteed by Part III of the Constitution".

The entire enlightening lecture was followed by an interactive session in which students raised concern on different issues like how far the judgment carries relevancy in today's scenario; in what manner and in which direction this judgment gives a message of social transformation; whether India should adopt the model of USA this and so on.



# Workshop on Corporate Social Responsibility and Social Audit, 31 Mar 2018

A Workshop on Corporate Social Responsibility and Social Audit was organized in which Prof. (Dr.) A.K. Mitra shared his thoughts on Corporate Social Responsibility and its reflection in Indian scenario. During the discussion, Dr. Mitra highlighted the benefits that businesses, trade associations and Governments can achieve by adopting Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) into their philosophy and operations.



The main objectives of workshop were to Describe CSR and increase awareness of how it may help businesses and governments, Show the benefits of CSR, using examples, Explore the extent to which CSR is already in use in the forest sector in Indian subcontinent and Identify barriers to its wider adoption and what support may be needed to overcome these barriers.

The entire enlightening event was followed by an interactive session in which students raised concern on different issues like how far the social audit carries relevancy in today's scenario; in what manner and in which direction this concept can be reflected in Indian law and so on.





# Webinar on Application of Partial Differential Equations, 04 Apr 2018

A webinar was organized for the students of B-Sc II Semester by the Department of Mathematics, SOBAS, RNBGU. Dr. Kalpana Sharma, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Manipal University Jaipur was the speaker of the session was. The objective of the webinar was to discuss and make the students understand the practical applications of PDE which is the integral part of the curriculum of their semester paper, Differential Equations.



In the session Dr. Kalpana briefed the students about classification of second order linear partial Differential Equation viz., Elliptical, Hyperbolic and Parabolic nature of linear PDE. She also discussed about one-dimensional, two-dimensional heats and wave equation, their solution using method of separation of variables. The speaker made the students understand the concepts with the help of numerical related to heat and wave equations.

In the end of the session the students raised their queries related to the topic like difference between ordinary Differential Equations and Partial Differential Equations, meaning of Linear Partial Differential Equations, order and degree of Partial Differential Equations. The students got detailed insight about the difference between one dimensional and two-dimensional heat equation which was explained with the help of a solid iron bar besides this the students also got the opportunity to learn about wave equation with the help of a string.



# First National Rural Marketing Seminar on “Rural Marketing: The Next Big Revolution”, 07 Apr 2018

First National Marketing Seminar on “Rural Marketing: The Next Big Revolution” was organized in which eminent speakers- Mr. Gaurav Nagpal- Senior Manager, Financial Planning and Analysis, Aircel, Mr. Sunil Sharma- Retired Chief Manager, Punjab National Bank, Dr. Ankita Dhamija Nagpal -Faculty of Rural Management, Lingayas University, Faridabad and Dr. Jyoti Jain-Faculty of Rural Management, JECRC University, Jaipur, discussed on various issues pertaining to Rural Marketing. The Seminar was divided into two sessions. # Guest Lecture on Corrosion and its Prevention

13 Apr 2018

Dr. Jyoti Joshi, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry, MNIT Jaipur delivered a guest lecture in Applied Chemistry for B.Tech. students on Corrosion and its prevention. In her lecture she explained the theories of corrosion, various types of corrosion, and preventive methods of corrosion through power point presentation.



Dr. Joshi said that there is no single figure for loss to the nation due to corrosion. It can be a minimum of 3.5% of the nation's GDP. Losses due to corrosion could be around Rs. 2.0 lakh crores per annum in India. Corrosion costs manifest in the form of premature deterioration or failure necessitating maintenance, repairs and replacement of damaged parts. She further said that in the US, total direct cost of corrosion is estimated at about 300 billion dollars per year; which is about 3.2% of domestic product. Corrosion has a huge economic and environmental impact on all facets of national infrastructure, from highways, bridges, buildings, oil and gas, chemical processing, water and wastewater treatment and virtually on all metallic objects in use.

Students asked various questions and their queries were satisfied by the speaker. Overall, it was a successful event.

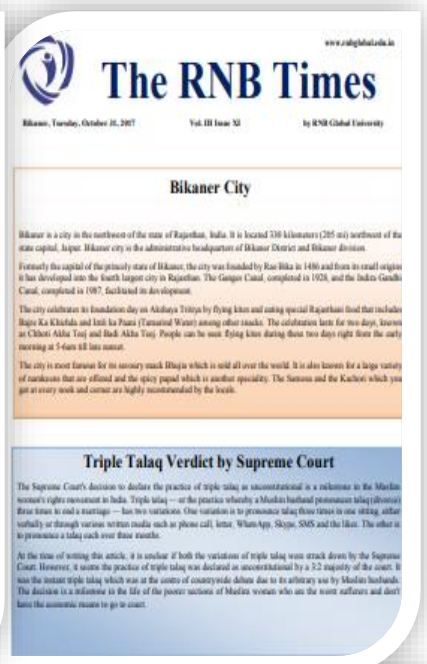

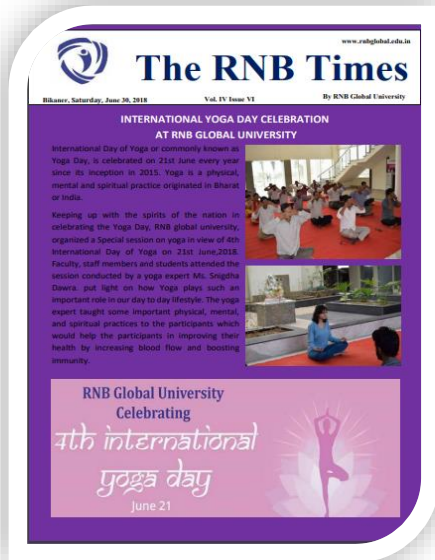

## एलोवीरा से क्रोनिक डीजनरेटिव बीमारियां ठीक होती हैं

सिटी रिपोर्टर, बीकानेर। एलोवीरा यानी ग्वारपाटे के इस्तेमाल से क्रॉनिक डीजनरेटिव बीमारियाँ दूर हो जाती हैं। इसका मुख्य कारण एलोवीरा में 12 विटामिनस, 18 अमिनो एसिड, 20 मिनरलस और 75 योगिक पौष्टिक तत्व और 200 सक्रिय एंजाइम्स होते हैं। ये सब शरीर में जमा विजातीय पदार्थों को बाहर निकाल देते हैं। इससे ब्लड शुगर, हार्ट अटैक, बीपी, क्लोन कैसर आदि लाइलाज बीमारियों से राहत मिलती है।

एनोवेरा मेडिसिन के रूप में कई मामलों में लाभदायक है। त्वचा और पाचनक्रिया मामले में ज्यादा फायदेमंद है। इस पर कई शोध हो चुके और कीमती मी मार्केट में आ चुकी हैं। मेडिकल क्षेत्र में इसकी महत्ता है।

# BIKANER CITY



Bikaner is a city in Rajasthan, India's northwest province. It is situated northwest of the state capital, Jaipur, 330 kilometres (205 mi). Bikaner City is the Bikaner District and Bikaner Division's administrative headquarters. Formerly the capital of Bikaner's princely state, the city was founded in 1486 by Rao Bika and has developed into Rajasthan's fourth largest city from its small origins. The 1928 Ganges Canal and the 1987 Indira Gandhi Canal facilitated its development. The city celebrates its founding day on Akshaya Tritiya by flying kites and eating special Rajasthani food which includes BajreKa Khichda and Imlika Paani. The celebration, called Chhoti AkhaTeej and Badi Akha Teej, lasts two days. The city is best known for its savoury Bhujia snack, which is sold throughout the world. It is also known for a wide range of namkeens and the spicy papad that is another specialty. that manufacture glass, pottery, felts, chemicals, shoes, and cigarettes. The city's colleges (including a medical school and a teachers' training institute) are affiliated with the University of Rajasthan in Jaipur.
