




World Class Infrastructure



We, therefore, engaged the services of leading architect and interior designer to deliver an architectural design that is both contemporary and modern. The room layout is designed in such a manner that there are well laid out spaces in every room. It has also been ensured that each room is bestowed with a sufficient supply of natural light. The dining hall is designed to hold substantially large crowd so that there is sufficient free space for resident students. We have enforced 24-hour security for all the residential blocks in the University. The pathways and the open areas around the hostel blocks are sufficiently illuminated to ensure absolute safety for the students and faculty. We have also installed IP cameras at all vantage points for added security. Students can indulge in games such as Table Tennis, Carrom, Chess, etc. We also have installed LED TV screens in the hostel to meet the infotainment requirements of the students.

RNBian's Visited District and Session Court Bikaner for Lok Adalat

14.09.2019, Students from school of Law, RNB Global university attended Lok Adalat, District and Session Court Bikaner. The Purpose of the visit was to understand the working of courts and the nature of duties of judicial officers in the matter of Lok Adalat .The visit was to help the students , understand the role of Lok Adalat in dispensing justice .The role of prosecutors in a case ,The way, cases proceed in the court ,The way judges and defence lawyers handle the case . The relationship between prosecutors and the police . The visit gave students, an opportunity to understand the actual need of co-ordination in the four pillars of Procedural Justice.

"Lok Adalat (People's Court) is one of Alternative dispute resolution mechanisms in India, it is a forum where cases pending or at pre litigation stage in a court of law are settled. People come to Lok Adalat to resolve their disagreements.

The visit started with a brief introduction of Concept of Lok Adalat and its procedure by the faculty in charge Mr. Ashok Karnani. After getting a brief knowledge of Lok Adalat an interactive session was held with Advocate Sanjay Vyas.

Additional District Judge and secretary of District Legal Services Authority Mr. Pawan Kumar Agrawal told the students that NALSA along with other Legal Services Institutions conducts Lok Adalats. Lok Adalat is one of the alternative dispute redressal mechanisms, it is a forum where disputes/cases pending in the court of law or at pre-litigation stage are settled/ compromised amicably. Lok Adalat have been given statutory status under the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. Under the said Act, the award (decision) made by the Lok Adalat is deemed to be a decree of a civil court and is final and binding on all parties and no appeal against such an award lies before any court of law. If the parties are not satisfied with the award of the Lok Adalat though there is no provision for an appeal against such an award, but they are free to initiate litigation by



approaching the court of appropriate jurisdiction by filing a case by following the required procedure, in exercise of their right to litigate. RJS MS. Yasmin Khan, asserted that there is no court fee payable when a matter is filed in a Lok Adalat. If a matter pending in the court of law is referred to the Lok Adalat and is settled subsequently, the court fee originally paid in the court on the complaints/petition is also refunded



back to the parties. Ms. Neetu Rani, RJS, stated the Nature of Cases to be Referred to Lok Adalat i.e.-

- 1. Any case pending before any court.
- 2. Any dispute which has not been brought before any court and is likely to be filed before the court.

Provided that any matter relating to an offence not compoundable under the law shall not be settled in Lok Adalat. As per section 18(1) of the Act, a Lok Adalat shall have jurisdiction to determine and to arrive at a compromise or settlement between the parties to a dispute in respect of -

- (1) Any case pending before; or
- (2) Any matter which is falling within the jurisdiction of, and is not brought before, any court for which the Lok Adalat is organized. Assistant Prosecution Officer Ms.Seema Solanki, Ms.Neetu Kumari, Ms.Savita Kumari, Mr. Sachin Chug also addressed the students and explained the procedure followed in courts. Being an infant among the law fraternity of the country, the School of Law is optimistic to repeat such type of learning programme for its learners by learning from the mistakes and screening the positives out of negatives with an eye giving birth to a 'learned community' having a point of their learning in RNB Global University, Bikaner, Rajasthan.

Moot Court Training for Law Students

24.01.2020 , **Day 1: 23rd January 2020**

Working Session 1: Decoding the Moot Proposition

At the Morning of 23.01.2020, the session was conducted by Mr. Anant having worked at Sharda Amarchand Mangaldas and Mr. Rachnendra practising litigation, for enhancing the mooting capability of the students. Soon after the Inaugural session, the first Working session on "Decoding the moot proposition" began. First, they discussed



about the extracting the material facts where we were told to read the moot problem, mark new words along with name of statutes and new concepts. Then we were told to analyse the applicable statutes in moot proposition which helped us to identify the law applicable in moot proposition.

Working Session 2: Examining sections of memorials

The session started primarily with examining the sections of memorials i.e. which sections are applicable to the moot proposition. Then we discussed about framing the issues and sub issues where we were guided to identify the material and immaterial facts. Lastly, they guided us as how to prepare the statement of jurisdiction where they gave us the MANTRA (Formula) i.e. ILAC (Issues Law Argument Conclusion)



Working Session 3: Preparing the Memorial Structure

This session started by them giving an overview of preparing the memorial structure where we were told that "Research is the most important part of any moot preparation. Research never ends, not even on the day of the moot. However, the formatting of your memorial is also very important, and many people tend to forget that which is why their memorial score is the reason for low team ranks".

Working Session 4: Discussion on 3rd Seth Jagan Nath Bajaj National Moot Competition-

We discussed about the moot proposition which our university is organizing, we got to know about the basics of drafting, specific word usage, hierarchy of authorities etc. It was very helpful to us as it made our work easier and which could save a lot of time while preparing a proposition as they've told us various shortcuts along with couple of strategies which would make our moot proposition presentable.

Day 2: 24th January 2020

Working session 1: Preparing the Memorial Structure 1st session of day 2 started with understanding the basic formatting tools for memorial making for e.g. Appropriate heading, fonts, header/footer, alignment, line and paragraph spacing, border, margins etc. Further we were guided as how to prepare complete memorial outline as earlier, we were unaware of these things, therefore, it helped us a lot in preparing memorials. We were guided as how to use MS word shortcuts for e.g. (Enter+ Ctrl+ Enter) for adding new page etc.



Working session 2: Drafting and finalizing the memorials The session started with learning the basics of memorial drafting where they guided us about the drafting styles and strategies, specific word usage, consistent drafting, capitalization, using of ILAC, etc. Then they discussed the IRAC method of drafting and they told us that IRAC is used after your facts section, in the discussion section or your memo, or the argument section of your brief.

Working session 3: Checks and touch ups This session started with discussing about drafting prayer and arguments synopsis, where they guided us about how the prayer must be short and precise which shall consist of all the relaxations which the party wants from the Hon'ble Court. Then they guided us through the final formatting checks and touch ups i.e. How to correct the citations, how to highlight your headings. Further, he guided us about how to generate the index and table of authorities with the use of MS word.

Working session 4: Bonus Tips In this session they've discussed about how to set the timeline for a moot i.e. within the prescribed time period within the guidelines. Then they guided us about how to manage the memorials within the page limits, they told us that how not to exaggerate things and how to write point-to-point. Further, they taught us how to make one's memorial appealing i.e. using of proper lines and spacings and how to decorate your memorial if needed. At last they solved our queries regarding the training program.



BIKANER CITY



Bikaner is a city in Rajasthan, India's northwest province. It is situated northwest of the state capital, Jaipur, 330 kilometres (205 mi). Bikaner City is the Bikaner District and Bikaner Division's administrative headquarters. Formerly the capital of Bikaner's princely state, the city was founded in 1486 by Rao Bika and has developed into Rajasthan's fourth largest city from its small origins. The 1928 Ganges Canal and the 1987 Indira Gandhi Canal facilitated its development. The city celebrates its founding day on Akshaya Tritiya by flying kites and eating special Rajasthani food which includes BajreKa Khichda and Imlika Paani. The celebration, called Chhoti AkhaTeej and Badi Akha Teej, lasts two days. The city is best known for its savoury Bhujia snack, which is sold throughout the world. It is also known for a wide range of namkeens and the spicy papad that is another specialty. that manufacture glass, pottery, felts, chemicals, shoes, and cigarettes. The city's colleges (including a medical school and a teachers' training institute) are affiliated with the University of Rajasthan in Jaipur.
