The incubation centre & Entrepreneurship Cell of RNBGU has been setup for innovation and developing entrepreneurship skills & to enable its students in getting firsthand experience in entrepreneurship, promote innovation driven activities and provide comprehensive and integrated range of support including space, mentoring, training programmes, networking and an array of other benefits.

Support as an incubator:

- RNBGU will provide a funding network in the form of financial support to young incubators and entrepreneur up to with the **amount of Rs.50,000/-**
- RNBGU will provide professional and managerial assistance in shaping the new creative ideas and aligning towards start-ups model.
- RNBGU will provide workspace and infrastructure in its domain knowledge.
- In addition to this, RNBGU will also act as virtual incubators for all the incubates, as in case of unavoidable circumstances. (as like in COVID-19).
- Any other assistance, which may be decided on case to case basis.

Few students have already shared the details & are now/will be part of the Incubation Centre.

However any student who has any idea and wants to join the incubation cell & not registered yet of their idea, they may submit their proposal to students' helpdesk for consideration.

Also if any student, who has done any kind of innovation or entrepreneurship work in last 2 years & have not registered with the incubation centre at RNBGU is still open to be a part of the same. They may also send their proposal/ideas to the students' helpdesk
