The TCS iON Digital Campus minor release v18.09.00 introduces enhancements under Academics, EnG Settings, Process Score, Report Card and Letter/RT and RV, Capture Score, Exam Attendance and Schedule, Fees and Fine Management, Student, Hostel.

With this release, A new column 'Exam Type' is added next to the Exclude grade column in the 'Configure Report Card for Bulk Generation' subtab wherein the user can exclude grades scored in select exam types for which the report card is not generated.

Also, an ABC ID required column has been added which if checked will only generate the deliverables of students if the ABC ID for the student exists in the system.

How to Use:

iDC > Self Services > Faculty Substitution Screen. Users should log in to Self Service and click/ search Faculty Substitution screen.

Select the role, enter the details as per the requirement in the applicable fields and click on search. The data will be reflected in the result area based on the selected filter criteria

For ECA-Y customers, enter the subject and student group for which data needs to be checked. 'Site' and 'Academic Session' are mandatory filters.

Click on the 'copy row' action button to copy the complete row and edit the row as per the requirement. Users can also create custom slots if required from this screen.

Introducing Bulk Template for Personal Account

With this release, iDC has introduced a new template 'Bulk Service Fee Adjustment'. In this template, all Student Details, Site, Batch, and Available balances will be auto-populated as per the filter selected while downloading.

Users have the option to update Service Master, Charge Group, and Service Amount as mandatory fields and Remark as optional.

Feature Benefits: The Bulk Service Fee Adjustment template will allow users to apply services to a student in bulk.

Collection Transactions A backend flag is used for this purpose, which will allow customers to use this workflow. When this flag is checked, the already available Reverse button in the Reverse Transaction screen will be removed and a new 'Raise Request' button will appear. This new screen will allow users to approve/reject Reverse Collection Transactions. Users will be able to add remarks while approving or rejecting. Feature Benefits: An approval layer for Reverse Collection transactions helps users check once before reverse. How to Use: Raise Reverse Transaction Request iDC > Fee > Fee Collection > View Fee Collection > Reverse Transection > Raise Request. Approve/Reject iDC > Fee > Refund Fee > Collection Transactions Approval > Approve / Reject

Introducing Offer Seats in Admission Workflow

With this release, iDC has introduced an option for users to offer seats at the time of Batch Allocation.

I we new columns are added in Batch Seat Allocation inside Academics Batch name as 'Total Offer Seats' and 'Available Offer Seats'. Total Offer Seats are always equal to or greater than Total Seats.

A new 'Enable waiting list' checkbox is provided in the Admission Process.

If ticked, at the time of Batch allocation for an applicant, available offer seats get reduced. In case of final admission for an applicant, total seats get reduced and in case of rejection of an applicant, available offer seats get increased.

Feature Benefits: Students/Admins will receive communication regarding any update at each level of workflow.

Admins have the option to provide an offer to a few applicants at the time of Batch Allocation and post confirmation from the applicant, the admin will complete final admission.
