

Copyright

- Academic publications and other unique creative works are protected by copyright, a sort of intellectual property protection.
- A copyright owner is granted certain exclusive rights for a predetermined period of time under copyright rules.
- This covers the only authority to distribute, copy, and make modifications to a work.

Licensing

- Copyright does not have to be an all or nothing game.
- The author could transfer copyright to a journal but the journal could elect to license back to the author certain rights (e.g. right to post the article on a personal website, the right to re-use images in future publications etc.).

Creative Commons Licenses

Condition	Icon	Definition
Attribution		You must give appropriate credit, provide a link to the license, and indicate if changes were made. You may do so in any reasonable manner, but not in any way that suggests the licensor endorses you or your use.
Non-Commercial		You may not use the material for commercial purposes.
Share Alike		You must distribute your contributions under the same license as the original.
No Derivatives		You may not modify the work (e.g. translations, edited edition etc.)

Every registered publisher or journal held in Romeo is carefully reviewed and analysed by our specialist team who provide summaries of self-archiving permissions and conditions of rights given to authors on a journal-by-journal basis where possible.

The policy information provided through this service primarily aims to serve the academic research community. Since the service launched over 15 years ago, publisher policies and the open access sector have changed a lot. Open access policy can be complex and varies according to geographical location, the institution, and the various routes to open access – all of which affects how and where you can publish your research.

All of the information provided by the service is correct to the best of our knowledge but should not be relied upon for legal advice.

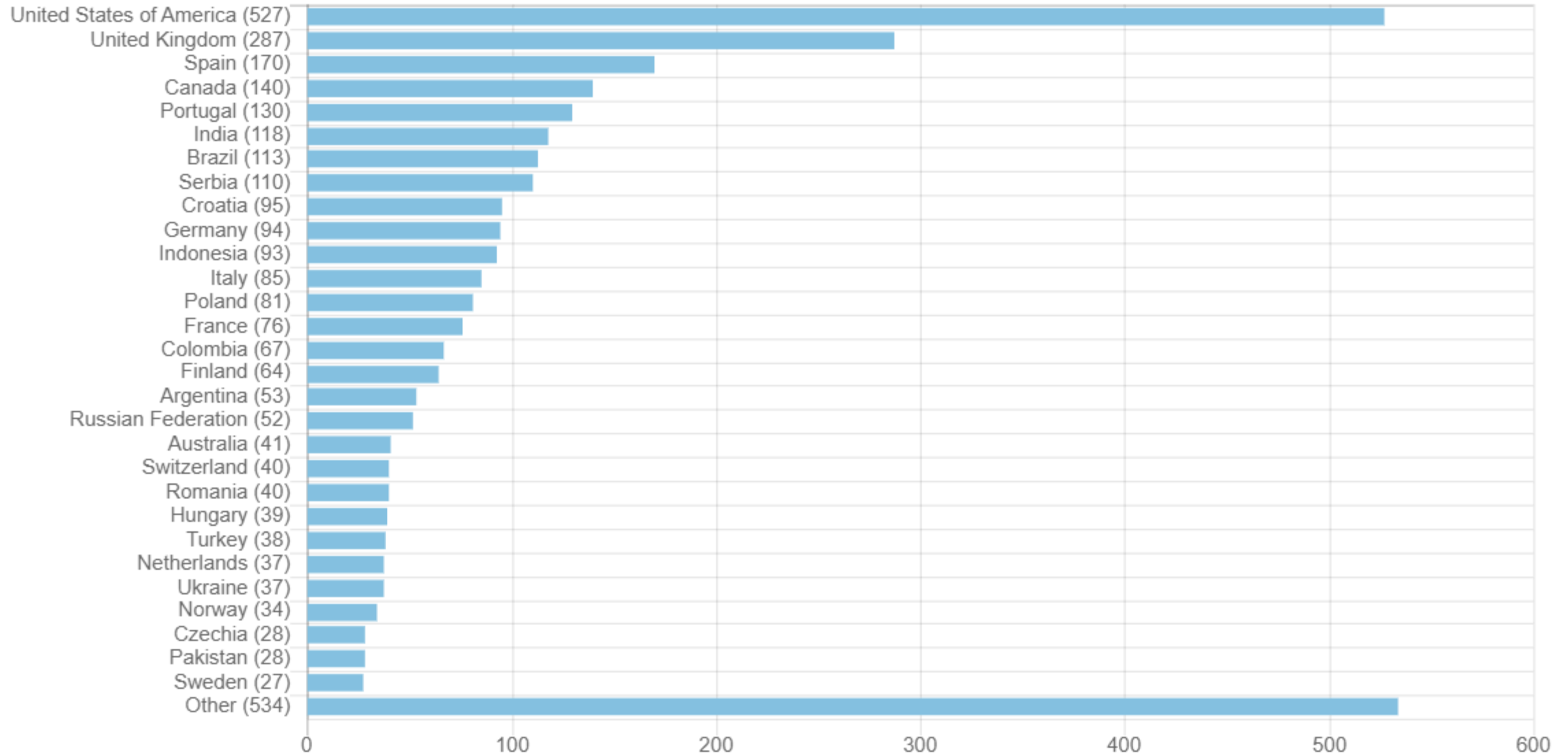

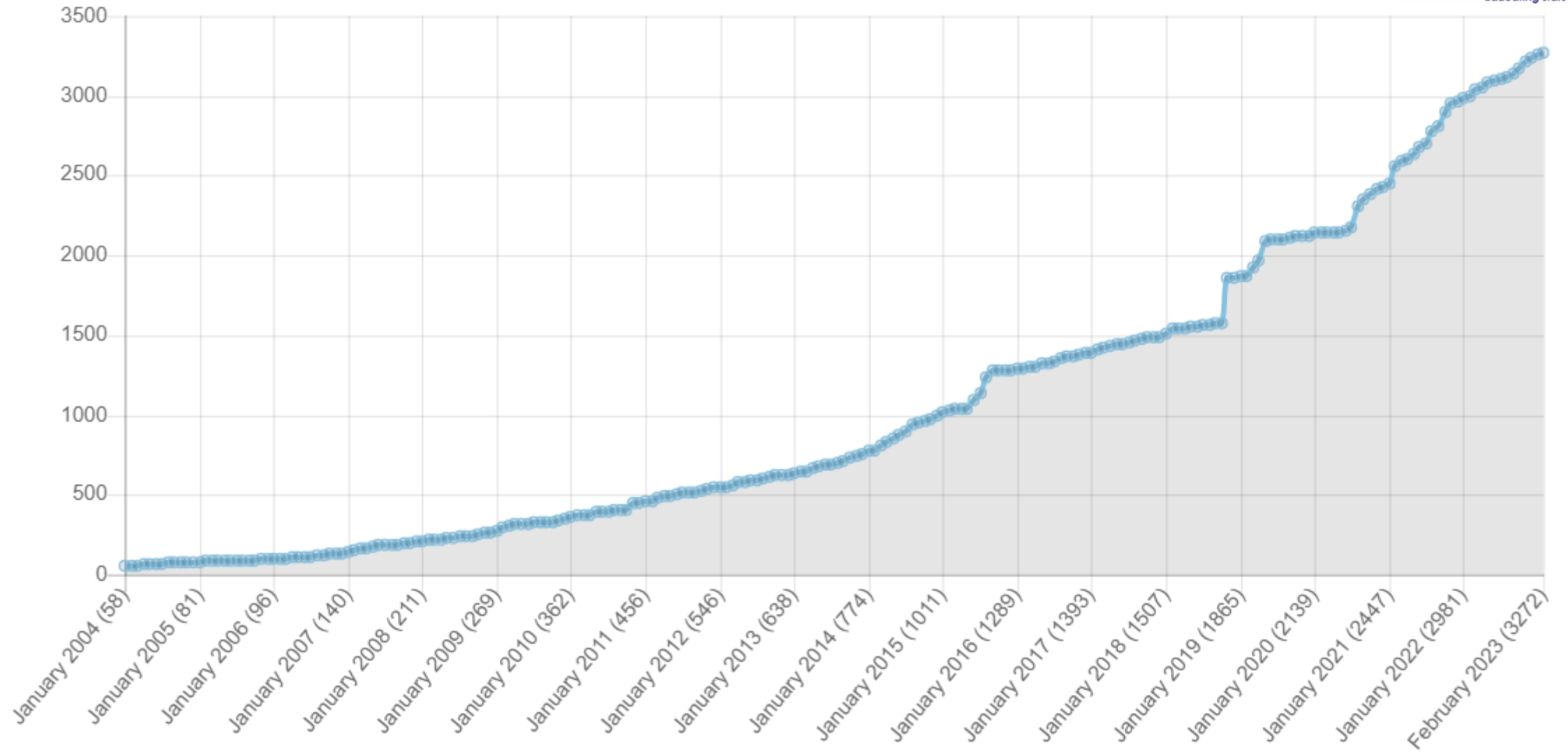
