- 2. In ASE also it was suggested to include one module which could have a bearing with stories and poetry so as to make the ASE subject more interesting.

- It was observed by the members that proper streamlining of Entrepreneurship syllabus is required in BBA and B. Com, since we are having combined classes of subjects.
- 4. It was suggested by the members to remove some repetitive topics in the syllabi of Team Building & Leadership
- It was suggested by the faculty members that one module of NISM should be compulsory for Finance students and inclusion of specialized accounting as a finance specialization.
