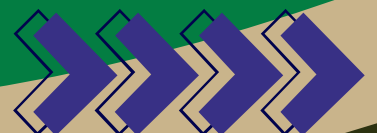

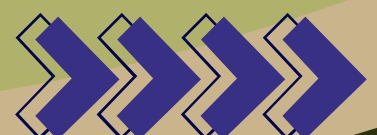


About RNB Global University

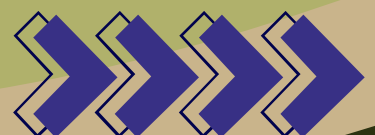
